Before me the undersigned Authority on this day personally appeared W. Pierce, who being

by me duly sworn on oath says that he resides in Hunt County Texas on the J. Roark 320 acre survey of land. That he has resided in that neighborhood ever since the year 1858. That he knows the locality of the original South boundary line of Hunt County, and of the N.W. Corner of Van Zandt County and the N.E. Corner of Kaufman County on the said South line of Hunt County.

Affiant further says that the original North East Corner of Kaufman County, as established by the original survey of said County line is about 40 varas north and about 200 varas East of the South West Corner of the J Roark survey of land. That said South boundary line of Hunt County is and has been since 1858. well known and the N.E. Corner of Kaufman County as originally marked has been well known to affiant since 1858 and is known to him now. That said original North East Corner of Kaufman County is the present N.W. Corner of Van Zandt County and is about one mile and a quarter South of the Corner marked and established by L. H. Bryant as the N.E. Corner of Kaufman County in 1882, or 1883. Affiant further says that the locality of the original South line of Hunt County has been well known and has been well defined since 1858.
