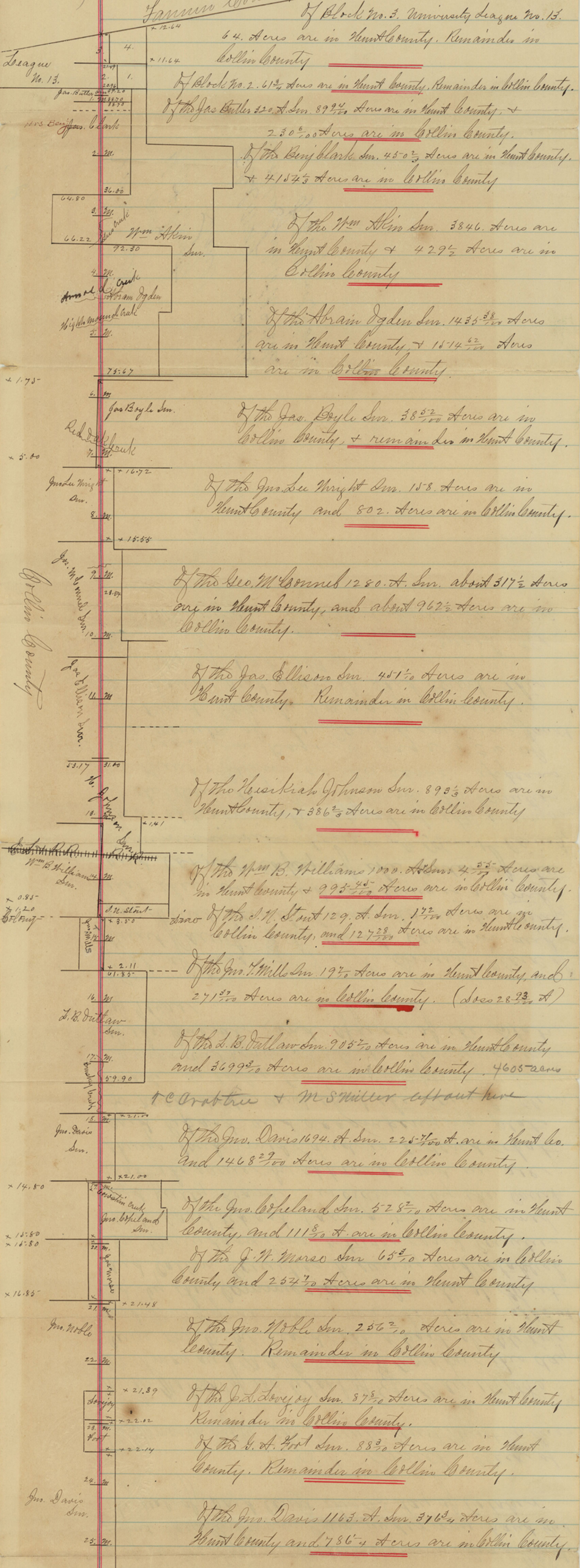

State of Texas } To the Hon. Commissioners

Whereas at the Nov. Term A. D. 1885-

the Commissioners Court of Hunt County, appointed
H. J. Kinney County Sur. of said County, to survey
the Boundary Line, between the Counties of Hunt
and Collin, and upon notice thereof, the
Commissioners Court of Collin County, appointed
W. H. Byrne, County Surveyor, of Collin County,
to represent said County, in the Survey of the
Boundary Line, between the said Counties of
Hunt and Collin

We the undersigned, surveyors above
mentioned, most respectfully report, that we
met, by mutual agreement, on the 24th day of
February A. D. 1886, and after mature deliberation,
we established the N. W. Cor. of Hunt Co. and
the Eastern N. E. Cor. of Collin Co., at a point on
that portion of the South Boundary Line of
Hunt Co., which was established by Jas.
Wilson and M. Keithley, September A. D. 1882;
at said point we set a Bois D'Arc post 5 feet long
