# Hunt & Fannin Co. Line

To the Hon. Commissioners Court  
of Hunt County Texas —

Whereas at the May Term A.D 1885  
the County Court of Fannin County  
Texas appointed W. Keithly Surveyor  
for Fannin County to resurvey the  
boundary line between Fannin and  
Hunt Counties, and upon notice  
thereof the beginning Court of Hunt  
Co. on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D 1885  
appointed H. Y. Rippy, Surveyor for  
Hunt Co. to represent said County  
in said resurvey of Boundary Line  
between the Counties of Fannin  
and Hunt, — The time designated  
being the 23<sup>d</sup> day of June A.D 1885

— We the undersigned Surveyors  
named in said order, most respect-  
fully report that we met on the 23<sup>d</sup>  
day of June A.D 1885, and after trying  
in vain to ascertain the variation  
of the old line (which we found to be a  
crooked line) we ran a trial line  
from the S E. cor. of Fannin County  
same being the N E. cor. of Hunt  
County, to intersect the North Boundary  
line of Collin County and the South  
Boundary line of Fannin County  
as established by Keithly and Wilson  
Sept 25, 26, 27, 28, A.D 1882. —

— The beginning or S E. cor. of Fannin Co. as well as the N E. cor. of


