





Dear Sir:

During the Month of Jan. 1929 while I was County Judge of Hutchinson County, Texas, in agreement with the County Judge of Hansford County, C.W. King, we authorized T.O. James to run and locate the County line between Hutchinson and Hansford County. The Commissioners Court of Hutchinson County had during the month of Dec. 1928 made arrangements with Mr. James and R.G. Armstrong, but after the new Court came into being Mr. Armstrong was not in the county and we authorized Mr. James to proceed with the work at once which he did and later filed his report with the Commissioner's Court of Hutchinson County and the same was approved and ordered filed.
