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Be it remembered that on the 29th day of April
A.D. 1876 there was begun and held a Call Term
of the Hon. Commissioners Court of Clay County
Texas at Henrietta. Present and presiding the
Hon W.B. Plemmons County Judge, A. Metzger
Commissioner presiding No 3 and A. Dawson
Presiding No 4, G. W. Alexander Clerk and J.
W. Gee Sheriff, when the following proceedings
were had to wit;

Order No 7. Ordered that by the Court that Sam Green
County Surveyor of Clay County Tex. be
and he is hereby appointed to run the dividing
line between Clay and Jack Counties Commenc-
ing said line at the South East Corner of
Clay County and the North East Corner of
Jack County, on the 1st Monday of June
A.D. 1876 and that the County Commission-
ers Court of Jack County be notified to
appoint some competent person to assist in
the running of said line and that the Clerk of
this Court be requested to send a certified copy
of this order to the presiding officer of the
Commissioners Court of Jack County Tex
immediately.

of Precinct No 2 J. R. Newcomb Commissioner
of Precinct No 3 and A. R. London Commissioner
of Precinct No 4. G. W. Ford County Clerk
G. L. Wright Sheriff. Court was opened by
proclamation of Sheriff when the following
proceedings were had to wit:

Order 36.

It appearing to the satisfaction of this Court
that the dividing line between Clay County and
Jack County is not sufficiently specified it is
hereby ordered that O. B. Patterson County Surveyor
of Clay County be appointed to proceed and
ascertain, survey and mark such line.

Beginning at the S. W. Corner of Montague
County and South East Corner of Clay County
And it is hereby ordered that the 22nd day of
September 1884 be the time set for surveying
said line and it is further ordered that the County
Clerk of Clay County cause a certified copy of this
order to be presented to the Commissioners of
Jack County at least ten days before
the time set for surveying said line.

In County Commissioners Court of Jack
County Texas, September 11th, 1884.

This day came on to be heard and con-
sidered the order of the County Commissioners
Court of Clay County Texas. (No. 36) ordering
O.B. Patterson County Surveyor of Clay County
to proceed and ascertain Survey and mark
the dividing line between the Counties of Clay
and Jack on the 22nd day of September 1884
which said Order is as follows:

"Order 36"

It appearing to the satisfaction of this Court
that the dividing line between Clay County and
Jack County is not sufficiently specified

It is here ordered that O.B. Patterson County

Surveyor of Clay County be appointed to proceed and ascertain Survey and Work such line. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Montague County, and South East corner of Clay County, and it hereby ordered that the 2nd day of September 1884 be the time set for surveying said line, and it is further ordered that the County Clerk of Clay County cause a certified copy of this order to be presented to the Commissioners of Jack County at least ten days before the time set for surveying said line."

And it appearing to the Court that heretofore to wit: on the 29th day of April 1876 the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Clay County, Texas, Made an order appointing Sam Green County Surveyor of Clay County, to run the dividing line between Clay and Jack Counties, commencing at the South East corner of Clay County, and the North East corner of Jack County. And it further appearing that the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Jack County, Texas, in pursuance of their notification of said order, did on the 29th day of May 1876 appoint H. Galloway Surveyor of Jack County, Texas, to meet said Sam Green at the time and place named in said order, to assist in running and establishing the line between said Counties of Clay and Jack. And it further appearing

that said Sam Green Co. Surveyor of Clay County
and the said W. Calloway Co. Surveyor of Jack
County. did in pursuance of the orders of their
respective County Commissioners Courts. and
according to the Statute in such cases made and
provided proceeded to Survey work designate and
establish said line between Clay and Jack
Counties. Which work was done on the 8th 9th and
10th days of June A.D. 1876. and the report and
field Notes thereof signed by both. said Sam
Green and W. Calloway. and filed in the County
Clerks Office of Jack County. on the 2nd day
of November 1876. and properly recorded in
on the Minutes of said Co. Comrs Court (M.R.D)
Journal, pages 147 and 148. It is therefore
ordered by the Court that J. M. Hughes County
Surveyor of Jack County, Texas. Do on the 22
day of September A.D. 1884 meet O. B. Patterson
County Surveyor of Clay County. at South East
Corner of said Clay County. and assist him in run-
ning the dividing line between the Counties of Clay
and Jack. and it is further ordered that he run
the line established by said Sam Green County
Surveyor of Clay County, and said W. Calloway
County Surveyor of Jack County as the same ap-
pears described in their report of the same. to their
respective County Courts.
