To The Honorable County Court of Jackson County
The undersigned P.P. Putnam County Surveyor
of Jackson County. Reports that in pursuance of
an Order of the County Court of Said County made at
the April Term 1886, That he proceeded at the time
and place fixed by Said Order to Survey establish
and mark the line between Jackson and Wharton at the S.
W. Corner of the latter County and the East Corner of Jackson
and N. W. Corner of Matagorda; (The Wharton Co Survey or not
meeting me at the appointed time); And after having run the
same did afterwards meet, (the 15th June 1886,) H. J. Schley, Co.
Surveyor of Wharton County and Fred S. Robbins Co. Surveyor
of Matagorda County, and together with the undersigned
agreed to the establishment of Said Corner and the said
H. J. Schley, Co. Surveyor of Wharton County who agreed to
the running of the line between Jackson and Wharton
Counties as evidenced by an agreement signed in duplicate
and of the Field Notes and Map, a copy of which is as follows:
