To The Honorable County Court of Jackson County  
 The undersigned P.P. Putnam County Surveyor  
 of Jackson County. Reports, that in pursuance of  
 an Order of The County Court of Said County made at  
 the April Term 1886, That he proceeded at the time  
 and place fixed by Said Order to Survey establish  
 and mark the line between Jackson and Wharton at the S.  
 W. Corner of the latter County and the East Corner of Jackson  
 and N. W. Corner of Matagorda, (The Wharton Co Surveyor not  
 meeting me at the Appointed time), and after having run the  
 same did afterwards meet, (the 15<sup>th</sup> June 1886,) H. J. Schley Co  
 Surveyor of Wharton County and Fred S. Robbins Co. Surveyor  
 of Matagorda County, and together with the undersigned  
 agreed to the Establishment of Said Corner and The Said  
 H. J. Schley Co. Surveyor of Wharton County who agreed to  
 the running of the line between Jackson and Wharton  
 Counties as evidenced by an agreement signed in duplicate  
 and of the Field Notes and Map, a copy of which is as follows:  
 Beginning at an Iron Post, Part of a Rail Road T Rail 7 feet  
 long and set 3 1/2 ft. in the ground, in the same place that a live  
 oak post was set (which now was broken down & in a thick growth  
 of Live Oak Bushes) by J. B. Collingworth in April 1861 near a  
 live Oak Burn, for the South Corner of Wharton County, and the  
 same point, that Geo. W. Brackensridge run from for Jackson and  
 Matagorda County line in <sup>the</sup> same year, as per Order from their respective  
 County Courts. Said Corner is between two Branches of the East  
 Carancahua, from which the N. E. Corner of the Lane White 320 acre  
 Survey Bns. N. 45° W. 600 Pcs. and the E. Boundary line of said Sur.  
 Bns. West 430 Pcs. and a Point 245 Pcs. E. of the S. E. Corner

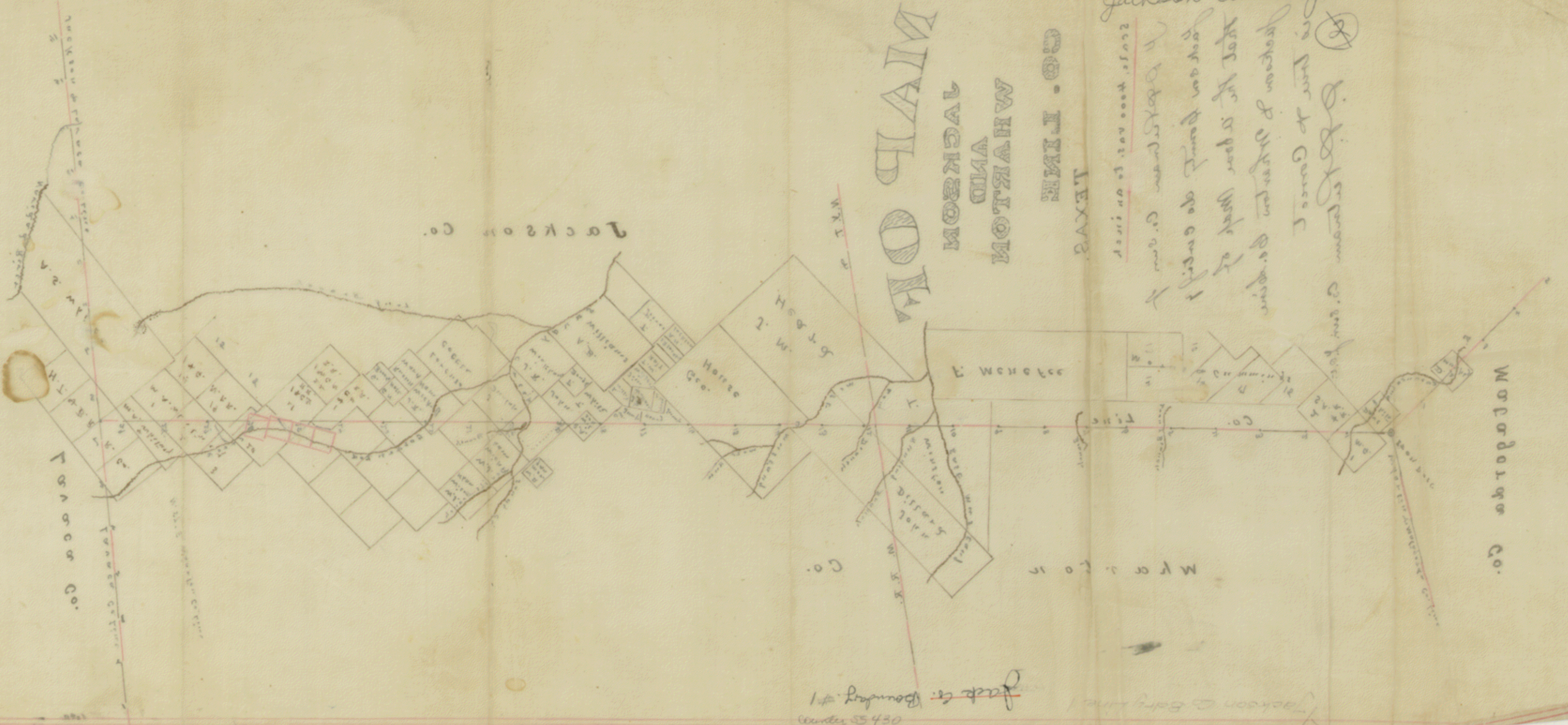
