

The State of Texas, Be it remembered that a
Johnson County. regular term of the Commission-
ers Court in and for Johnson County, Texas, was begun
and held at the Court House of said County in the
Town of Cleburne on the 2nd Monday in November
A. D. 1881, the same being the 14th day of November,
1881.

Present: Hon. W. J. Ewing, County Judge, and
S. Hughes, A. J. Reeves, S. K. Davis and J. A. Baugh,
Commissioners in and for Johnson County, Texas.
There were also present Jn: L. Brown, Sheriff and
H. E. Adams, Clerk of the County Court of Johnson
County, Texas.

Be it remembered that on the second day
of the term aforesaid on the 15th day of November,
1881, the said Court made and caused to be entered
of record an order in words and figures as follows:

"The Court thereupon proceeded to the ex-
amination of 'Report of Survey of County line
of Hood and Johnson Counties' made under and by
virtue of an order of this Court of date August
10th, 1881 which said Report together with Exhibit
'A' (plot of line between said Counties) accom-
panying said Report, is in words and figures
following, viz:

To the Hon. Comrs. Court, Johnson County Texas.

In obedience to your order, made at your
August regular term, (recognizing the claim of Hood County that
the county line between said county and Johnson is not sufficiently
defined, and naming September 1st 1881 as the day to commence
the establishing of the same I proceeded in conjunction

with the surveyor for Hood County, to fix said boundary in accordance with the act of the Legislature, entitled an act establishing and prescribing the manner of ascertaining the boundaries of counties. Approved April 10th 1890 and herewith submit my actions, with plat and field notes of the survey of line between Johnson and Hood counties.

We began our work at the S.E. cor. of Hood County in the W. Bndy. line of Johnson, which point was fixed by the intersection of the S. Bndy. of Hood and W. Bndy. of Johnson county. The original marked line of each of these boundaries, was unmistakably discernible near the initial point, enabling us, by intersecting as above named, to fix this point in strict conformity with the original survey. We found this cor. to stand in the Vincente Soto Survey 940 vrs. S. 60° W. and 400 vrs. S. from the N.W. cor. of the Albert Pratt Survey, a cedar post 8 in. diameter set 3 feet in the earth, for the S.E. cor. of Hood County in the W. Bndy. line of Johnson County.

(1.) Thence N. 1900 vrs. the 1st mile, a mound of stone in the Vincente Soto Survey, a rock mound 2 feet high.

(2.) Thence N. at 3700 vrs. crosses river, at 5000 vrs. the 2nd mile in the bed of S. d. river

(3.) Thence N. at 3860 vrs. crosses the river, at 5700 vrs. the 3rd mile in the bed of the river

Thence N. at 5760 vrs. crosses the river, at 6015 vrs. the N. Bndy. line of the S. B. Patton 120 acre survey, 270 vrs. N. 60° E. from the N.W. cor. of the same, and 560 vrs. S. 60° W. from the S.E. cor. of the E. Spears Survey, at 7190 vrs. crosses Rashes Branch, at 7600 vrs. the 4th mile, a mound of rock 2 feet high.

(5.) Thence N. at 8560 vrs. passes the N. bndy. of C. B. Tisdals Survey, 200 vrs. E. from the N.W. cor. of the same, at 9500 vrs. the 5th mile, a rock mound 2 feet high in the G. B. Temison survey.

(6.) Thence N. at 9732 vrs. the S. line of J. D. Bellas Survey, 648 vrs. from the S.E. cor. of the same, at 10548 vrs. the S. line of S. B. Patton's 110 acre survey, 473 vrs. W. from the S.E. cor. of the same, at 11400 vrs. the 6th mile, a rock mound 2 feet high
