At the Gen. Commissioners Court Johnson County.

In obedience to your order
at September term 1881, I met the surveyor
of Tarrant County, and we proceeded to establish,
definitely, the boundary line between Johnson & Tarrant.
Reversing on the field notes for the Western boundary
of Tarrant County, as made by A. G. Walker, about
1854, we established the S.W. cor. of Tarrant County.
This point we identified, by the field notes above men-
tioned, and are satisfied that this corner stands,
where it was placed, by the said A. G. Walker,
in Johnson County School Land Survey No. C.
2965 - 19s. W. and 980 1rs. S. from the N.E. cor. of same,
and 60 1rs. E. of the divide of a ravine, that runs N. into
Bear Creek, and S. into Mustang Creek. The monument
for this corner, a large stone, set in the earth two feet high
and marked 1881 P.T. whence the chimney in the center of
Withers residence, b.s. S. 43° W. and the chimney at the E. end of J. L.
Goforth's residence b.s. N. 3° 40' W. and the capstone on
his barn b.s. N. 4° 30' W. and a lone live oak, on a high
prairie, b.s. N. 3° 30' O. From this point, we proceeded
E. on an air line, using a transit, and turning
off a right-angle at S.W. cor. of Tarrant, running
through the entire line without the use of the needle.
Magnetic Variation red by instrument on W.
B. line of Tarrant County 9° East.

Hence E. from S.W. cor. at 1900 1rs. the 1st mile, a
large stone buried in the earth, and a stone & dirt
mound 2 feet high over the buried stone, which
stands on the N. Bank of a draw running E. 90 1rs. W.,
from a draw running South.

Whence C. at 2965 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Johnson County School Land
980 yrs. S. of its N. E. cor. ^{at} 20 yrs. N. of the S. W. cor. of Debby Morris Sur-
vey and N. W. cor. W. H. Landrum, at 3509 yrs. a drawn course. South, at
3800 yrs. the 2nd mile, a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high, marked
2. whence Cade Peak hrs. S. $53^{\circ} 10' E.$ and the residence of Mr. Fletcher
in Tarrant County on the Heath Survey, hrs. N. $46^{\circ} E.$

Whence C. at 4448 yrs. a drawn, course S. E. at 4664 yrs. another nd larger
draw, the line crossing the latter 36 yrs. N. of the confluence of the two,
at 5700 yrs. the 3rd mile, a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high, stand-
ing on the E. slope of a hill nd marked 3.

Whence C. at 6478 yrs. the E. B. line of Debby Morris, 20 yrs. N. of its S. E.
corner nd the W. B. line of the A. Martin Survey, 20 yrs. N. of its S. W. cor. at
6528 yrs. the W. bank of Mustang Creek, at 6560 yrs. the center of channel of sd.
creek, at 6575 yrs. the E. bank of same at a large Elm marked. ^X on the N
side - the tree standing 8 yrs. S. of the mouth of a ravine running into
Mustang from the East. at 6636 yrs. enters the prairie on the E. side of
the timber or mustang, where a high hill stands N. of the line nd, a ravine
of scrubby Elms stands S. of the line which passes on the S. edge of
the S. E. slope of sd. hill, at 6942 yrs. the line crosses the ravine
referred on S. of line, near the head of sd. ravine, where a lone
Elm stands 50 yrs. N. of the line. at 7428 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Martin Survey,
20 yrs. N. of its S. E. cor. nd 20 yrs. N. of the S. W. cor. of an unknown survey. at 7600 yrs. X
the 4th mile, a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high marked 4.

Whence C. at 7740 yrs. a ravine, course North, at 7978 yrs. the W. B. line of Tom
Gilleland Survey 350 yrs. N. from S. W. cor. at 9500 yrs. the 5th mile (marked 5) a
large stone set in the earth. Whence C. at 9604 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Gil-
leland nd the W. B. line of an unknown survey ~~(22 yrs. wide)~~ 330 yrs. N. from
the S. E. nd S. W. corners respectively, at 9826 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. unknown
survey & the W. B. line of R. L. Franklin, 450 yrs. N. of the S. W. cor. of latter ^X
at 10806 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Franklin & W. B. line of W. N. Riddle 500 yrs. X
S. of the N. E. & N. W. cors. respectively. at 11700 yrs. the 6th mile, a large stone
set in the Earth 2 feet high marked 6.

Thence Q. at 11966 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Biddle and W.B. line of J. S. Armstrong, 280 vrs. N. of the S.E. and S.W. corners respectively, at 12156 vrs. Rock Creek, course North, at 12391 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Armstrong and W.B. line of S.B. Kirkham, 280 vrs. N. of the S.E. and S.W. corners respectively, at 13300 vrs. the 7th mile, a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high marked 7. This monument stands in a peach orchard on the E. side of sd. Kirkham survey. Thence Q. at 13382 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Kirkham and W.B. line of McKinney and Williams or Socorro Farming Co., 280 vrs. N. of the S.E. and S.W. corners respectively, at 14190 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Farming Co. and W.B. line of R. Doggett 200 vrs. S. of sd. Doggett's N.W. corner, at 14668 vrs. Doggett's Branch, course N.W. at 15200 vrs. the 8th mile, a large stone set in the earth marked 8 standing 20 vrs. W. from a ravine.

Thence Q. at 15220 vrs. a ravine, at 15242 vrs. another ravine, at 15538 vrs. the E.B. line of R. Doggett and W.B. line of J. Boden (and the center of Cleburne and Fort Worth Stage road), 200 vrs. South of the N.Q. and N.W. corners respectively, at 15920 vrs. enters a peach orchard on the W. side of sd. Boden, passing S. of the N. row of trees in sd. orchard, at 16892 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Boden 200 vrs. S. of his N.E. cor. and 136 vrs. S. of the N.W. cor. of J. Dodson Survey, at 17100 vrs. the 9th mile a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high & marked 9.

Thence Q. at 18190 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Dodson 136 vrs. S. of his N.Q. cor. and 75 vrs. N. of his N.S.E. cor. and the W.B. line of the P. Coldwell 75 vrs. N. of his S.W. cor. at 18684 vrs. the S. prong of Deer Creek just N. of the N.W. of B. Branson's horse lot on the P. Coldwell Survey, at 19000 vrs. the 10th mile, a large stone set in the earth 2 feet high marked 10. RSE.

Thence Q. at 19110 vrs. the Q. A. line of P. Coldwell and W.B. line of W. Mendoza, 75 vrs. N. of the S.E. cor. of sd. Coldwell, at

20063 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Mendoza and W. B. line of G. W. Corbett
282 yrs. N. of the S.W. cor. of sd. Corbett. at 20900 yrs. the 11th. mile, a stone X
set in the earth below the surface by the side of the W. Rail of the
Santa Fe R.R. marked 11, whence a cedar Telegraph pole
marked x stands 30 feet - W. $\frac{3}{4}$ 170 feet N. of the buried stone.
Hence E. at 21100 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Corbett 23 yrs. S. 45° W. from the
N. E. cor. of same and 644 yrs. S. 45° W. from the S.W. cor. of
H. G. Cattell. at 22017 yrs. the E. B. line of sd. Cattell and W. B. line of H.
Alsbury, 644 yrs. S. 45° E. from the N. E. and N. W. corners respec-
tively, at 22196 yrs. enters the timber on W. side of what is known
as "Brushy Knot", near the residence of James Thompson, the
line passing between his smoke house and residence, (the former
South line and latter North) entering the timber at a P.C. 12 in
diameter, marked with 5 hicks on the S. side and X on the N.
side, sd. tree 6 inches N. of the line. at 22800 yrs. the 12th
mile, a very large sand stone, notched N and S. and 12
cut on E. side of the scotch.

Hence E. at 23012 yrs. the highest point on sd Brushy Knot on the line
at 23857 yrs. the S.E. B. line of sd. Alsbury 125 yrs. N. 45° E. from
the S.W. cor. of same and the N.B. line of another H.G. Cattell
lance 644 yrs. S. 45° W. from the N.E. cor. of same, at 24700 yrs.
the 13th. mile a stone set in the earth marked 13.

Hence E. at 24712 yrs. the N.E. B. line of sd. Cattell and S.W. B. line
of Sarah Gray 125 yrs. N. 45° W. from the S.E. cor. of sd. Cattell
and 1084 yrs. N. 45° W. from the S.W. cor. of Sarah Gray, at 25549 yrs.
the W.P.R.R. at 26524 yrs. a spring of Village Creek, at
26600 yrs. the 14th mile, a large stone set in the earth
2 feet high, marked 14.

Hence E. at 26996 yrs. the E.B. line of Sarah Gray and W. B. line of A. Lee
1120 yrs. N. of the S.E. and S.W. corners respectively, at 27536 yrs. Fort Worth & Alvarado
road, at 28220 yrs. a ravine, running into Village Creek, which is S. of the line.

at 28500 vrs. the 15th mile, a stone set in the earth marked 15.

Thence E. at 29402 vrs. Village Creek, curve at crossing of line A. at 29835 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Lee 1120 vrs. N. of the S.E. cor. of same ^{and} 162 vrs. N. of S.W. cor. of J.M. Zambrano, at 30400 vrs. the 16th mile in the E. edge of a small prairie, a very lge stone 3 feet high, marked 16, whence a P.O. 10 in di. marked T. brs. N. 81° E. 8 vrs. ^{and} a P.O. 10 in di. marked T. brs. N. 46° E. 3 vrs.

Thence E. at 31607 vrs. aravine, at 31700 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Zambrano 162 vrs. N. of its S.E. cor. at 32100 vrs. the W.B. line of W.B. Mumford. 102 vrs. S. 30° E. from his S.W. cor. at 32300 vrs. the 17th mile, a large stone set in the earth marked 17.

Thence E. at 33110 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Mansfield 335 vrs. N. 30° W. from S.E. cor. of same, in N.B. line of W.B. Stout, at 33564 vrs. passes the N.W. cor. of Nichols $\frac{1}{2}$ vrs. N. of same, at 33578 vrs. the N.B. line of sd. Nichols, at 34200 vrs. the 18th mile, a very large mound of sandrock rock, covered over with earth & a rock on top marked 18.

Thence E. at 34642 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Nichols 542 vrs. S. 30° E. from the N.E. cor. of same, ^{and} 44 vrs. N. 30° W. from S.W. cor. J.S. Hampton, at 35555 vrs. the S.E. B. line of J.S. Hampton ^{and} N.W. B. line of J. Johnson 25 vrs. S. 30° W. from N.E. cor. of sd. J. Johnson, at 35-5-90 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Johnson ^{and} W.B. line of J.W. Haynes, at 35-990 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Haynes ^{and} W.B. line of B.B.B&C.R.R. Co. 267 vrs. S. from the N.E. ^{and} N.W. corners respectively, at 36100 vrs. the 19th mile, a large stone 2 feet high marked 19.

Thence E. at 36521 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. R.R. Co. ^{and} W.B. line of J.W. Haynes 267 vrs. S. of the N.E. ^{and} N.W. corners respectively, at 36872 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Haynes, 267 vrs. S. of N.E. corner, ^{and} W.B. line of E. Gibbs 267 vrs. + S. of its N.W. cor.. at 37792 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Gibbs ^{and} W.B. line of S.T. Allen, 280 vrs. S. of the N.E. ^{and} N.W. corners respectively. at 38000 vrs. the 20th mile a stone 2 feet high marked 20.

Thence E. at 38113 vrs. the E.B. line of sd. Allen ^{and} W.B. line of H. Langston 288 vrs. N. 30° W. from S.W. cor. of sd. Langston, at 38699 vrs. the S.B. line

fed Langston nd N.B. line of S.S. Carpenter, 28 yrs. S. of
N. from S.E. cor. of H. Langston and 379 yrs. N. 60° E. from
N.W. cor. of sd. Carpenter, at 38723 yrs. passes the S.E. cor. of
sd. Langston, 14 yrs. due S. of same, at 39900 yrs. the
21st mile, a stone set in the earth 2 feet high marked 21.
Hence Q. at 40385 yrs. the E.B. line of sd Carpenter and W.B. line
of J. Bridgeman 832 yrs. S. 30° E. from the N.E. nd N.W. cor. and
respectively, at 40766 yrs. Walnut Creek, at 40868 yrs. crosses sd
creek again, at 41720 yrs. crosses Walnut Creek again, at
41800 yrs. the 22nd mile a large stone marked 22.M.

Hence Q. at 42682 yrs. the S.B. line of J. Bridgeman nd
N.B. line of W. D. Dickey 75 yrs. S. 60° W. from S.E.
cor. of sd. Bridgeman, at 42788 yrs. the W.B. line of
T.J. Banks, 1850 yrs. N. 30° W. from S.W. cor. of same, at
43400 yrs. enters the prairie, at 43700 yrs. the 23rd
mile, a large stone 2 feet high marked 23.

Hence Q. at 45600 yrs. the 24th mile, a large stone marked 24.

Hence Q. at 46307 yrs. the E.B. line of Sd. Banks, 97 yrs. N. 30°
W. from S.E. cor. of same, and S.W. cor. W.C. Price, at 46550
yrs. the W.B. line of sd. Price nd N.B. line of D. McQueen 174
yrs. N. 60° E. from N.W. cor. of same, at 47800 the 25th
mile, a large stone 2 feet high marked 25.

Hence Q. at 48400 yrs. the S.B. line of Sd. McQueen
128 yrs. S. 60° W. from S.E. cor. of same, at 48580 yrs.
W.B. line of Inv. Robertson, at 48762 yrs. N.B. line of
D. Delay, at 49002 yrs. E.B. line of sd Delay nd W.B.
line of Inv. Robertson, at 49400 yrs. the 26th mile, a
large stone 2 feet high marked 26.

Hence Q. at 49812 yrs. the S.B. line of
Inv. Robertson, nd N.B. line of Mitchel,
at 51272 yrs. we erected a monument in

in the Mitchel Survey, which
stands 280 rs. N. 30° W. and 72 rs.
W. from the S. E. cor. of sd Mitchel.
This monument is subject to such change
E. or W. as the line between Ellis and John-
son may require, and cannot be fixed
until the boundary of Johnson and Ellis is def-
initely located; and would respectfully recom-
mend the early settlement of this boundary.
