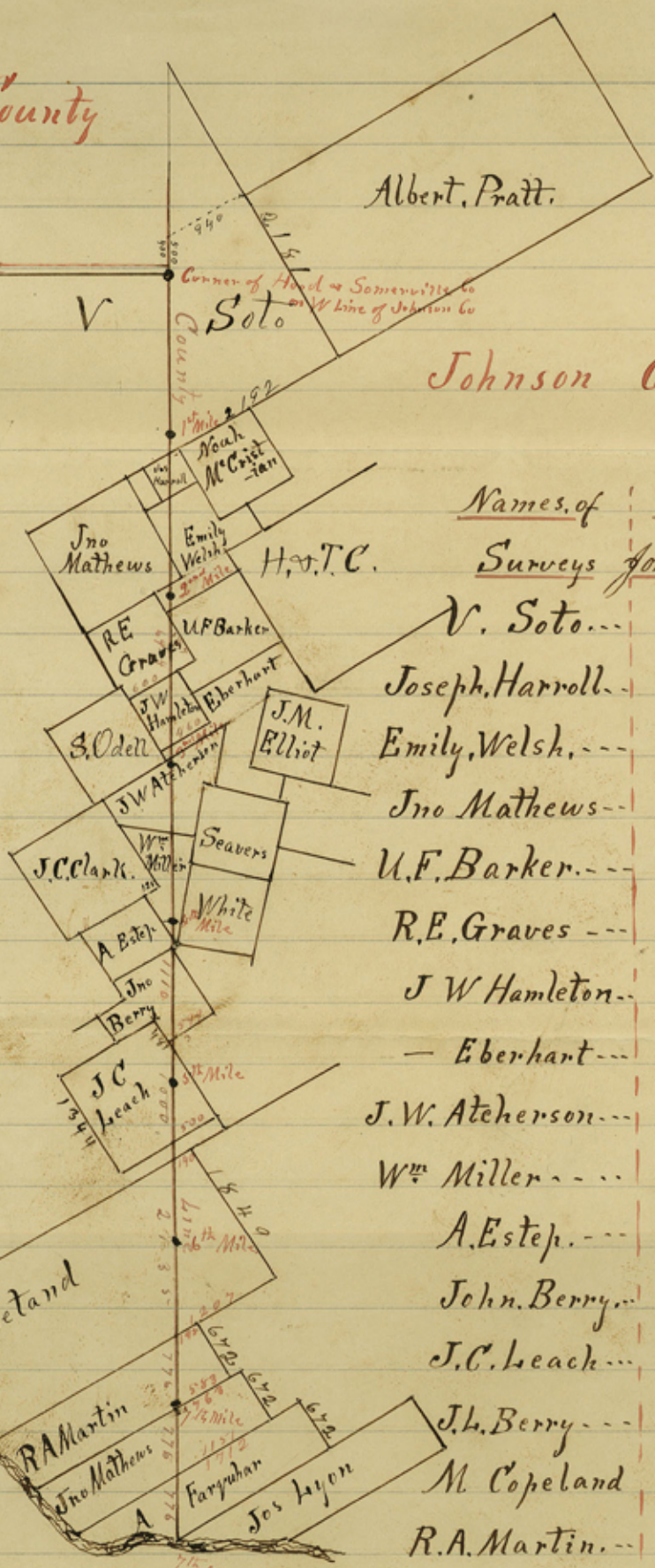

To the Honorable Commi-
sioners Court of Johnson County Texas

In Obedience
to your Order issued at the May term 1884
demanding the County line between Johnson and
Somerville Counties to be surveyed according to
law and fixing the 25th of Aug as the day for
the said Survey to be commenced

I proceeded in
Conjunction with the County Surveyor of
Somerville County and in accordance with your
Order to Establish the said Boundary line and
herewith submit my Returns with plat and
field notes of the Survey Between Johnson
and Somerville Counties

We began our work at
the S E corner of Hood County in the West line
of Johnson County which point was fixed by
a Survey made to establish the true line
between Johnson and Hood Counties (Commencing
Sept the 1st 1881) Said work was approved
by the Commissioners Court and recorded in the
Minutes thereof we found the corner described
by the Surveyors Report above referred to
to stand in the Vincent Soto Survey 940 vrs
S 60 W and 500 vrs S of the N W corner of the
Albert Pratt Survey instead of 940 S 60 W and
400 vrs South as Reported said corner was
marked by a Cedar post 8 in dia set in the
Earth for the corner of Hood County
After noting this Error of 100 vrs South

we run Thence South at 1900 was the
 first mile a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high}
 Soto Survey, at 2004 was the S. line of V
 Soto Survey 60 was S60 W from the NE corner
 of Joseph Harroll Survey, at 3210 was
 the E line of John Mathews Survey, at 3557
 was the S line of said Mathews 173 was
 S60 W from the SE corner of same, at
 3800 was a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high} the 2nd
 mile crossed R E Graves South line
 600 was N60 E of his S W corner at 5700 was
 a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high} the 3rd mile at 7600
 was a large Stone mound the 4th mile
 at 7720 was the E line of A Estep Survey
 170 was N30 W of its S E corner
 at 9115 was the E line of J L Leach
 Survey 481 was S30 E from its NE cor
 at 9800 was a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high} the
 fifth mile which stands on the Leach
 Survey at 10497 was the N line of Martin
 Copeland Survey 140 was S60 W from his NE
 corner at 11400 was a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high} on
 the W Bank of a Branch the 6th mile
 at 13300 was a large Stone mound, ^{2 feet high} the
 7th mile at 14960 was the S W corner of
 the A Farquahar Survey, ^{and NW corner of Joseph Lyon Survey} on the Bank
 of the Brazos River and the corner of
 Johnson County a large Stone mound
 of Fred. T. Vickers County

 I made the above Survey in obedience to
 an Order of the Commissioners Court of

Matthews, County Judge of Somervell County, Texas, a certified copy of the order of this Court of date May 15, 1884 in regard to a Survey of the boundary line between this ^{and} Somervell Counties, which facts appear by return of E. H. Chandler, Sheriff of said Somervell County, Texas, on precept issued herein and accompanying said certified copy as aforesaid and which precept with said return of said Sheriff thereon, is now of file in this office, and whereas it also appears in evidence to the satisfaction of the Court, that the Surveyor appointed in behalf of Johnson County has proceeded as required by law and the order of this Court in regard to said Survey; ^{and} whereas it appears to the Court upon an examination of report ^{and} accompanying plat now here submitted by the said Fred S. Vickers, Surveyor, that the same conform to the law, and from the evidence adduced on the hearing hereof that the said Report ^{and} plat contain the facts as the same in truth exist. It is, therefore, ordered that the said Report ^{and} plat accompanying same as recorded on pp. 236, 237 & 238 of this Record be ^{and}

the same are hereby approved and admitted to record on the Minutes of the Court at this Term.
