day of March A.D. 1874.

It appearing to this Court that the
County Court of Karnes County has directed
the surveyor of said County to proceed on the
27th day of April A.D. 1874, to ascertain the
boundary line between the County of Wilson
and the said County of Karnes - It is hereby
ordered that the County Surveyor of Wilson
County do attend and co-operate with the
Surveyor of Karnes County in running and
planning designating and establishing the
boundary line between the said two Counties,
of Wilson & Karnes. And the Clerk of
this Court is directed to furnish the County
Court of Karnes County with a copy of this
order, and a copy also to the County Surveyor
of Wilson County -

County of Karnes } of Karnes County Texas.

In obedience to an order of the
County Court of Karnes County, on the 28th day
of January 1874, ordering me, to proceed on the
first day of March 1874 to ascertain Survey and
plainly designate and mark the Boundary
line between this County and Willson County
by commencing at the N. W. corner of Karnes
County; and the County Court of Willson County
having been furnished with a Certified Copy of
said order; I proceeded, on the first ^{23rd} day
in March, to the N. W. corner, of Karnes, and
the Surveyor of Willson County failing to meet
me, and after making examination to ascertain
where the N. W. corner, of Karnes County was
established and finding none; notice was
given, to the County Court, of Willson that
Sitting the 27th day of April 1874, and to
Begin at the N. E. corner of Karnes County
as originally established, and Running with
the Call as given in the Act; which gives
Willson County $4\frac{3}{4}$ miles off, the North
part, of Karnes, and asking their cooperation
in the running, and paying one half the expense
and Willson County Court, did on the 30th
day of March pass an order, to wit,

It appearing to the Court, that the

County Court of Karnes County has directed
the Surveyor of said County to proceed on the
27th day of April A. D. 1874, to ascertain the bound-
ary line between the County of Wilson and the said
County of Karnes - It is hereby ordered that the
County Surveyor of Wilson County do attend
and cooperate with the Surveyor of Karnes County
in running and plainly designation and
establishing the Boundary line between the
said two Counties of Wilson & Karnes, -
The Surveyor of Wilson County, in obedience to
said order did meet me at the original
Corner of Karnes County, on the 27th day
of April and we began at the N. E. cor-
ner of Karnes as first established, at a Stake
from which a Saw oak marked + bears
N 32 1/2 W 27 varas, this Corner stands on the
North Side of Clear fork of Sandee near
Mr John Sick's House, Run S 41 E
with W. Boundary line of Gonzales County
(1 1/4 miles), 9025 varas, to a Saw oak
K & W from which a Saw oak 24 in dia
marked K. & W. bears N 84° 20' W 7 varas
marked Saw oak 16 in dia N. X W. bears
N 35 3/4 W 10 varas, here we found the
Corner of the two Counties as established
heretofore, thence S 51 W with the line
as first Run. which we found plainly

marked. Running through the Burnett O King
E. Smith, Thoms Hodge, J. Cole, W. H. Smith
and passed through the J. F. Rodriguez
League and Sabore Cropped, the W. B. line
of said League and Sabore, 730 rods
N. 30° W from its S. W. corner, in this
Survey, Cropped the Eclote Creek, mark
on the Creek, Linnal trees X, and cross
the San Antonio Road, in this Survey
mark, a Past, Creek, X, passed on
through the Sanders, Davis, and crossed
the Cibola River in the Pelu, Morgan
Survey, as, appears, from the maps, mark
a Pecan, X, on the East. Bank, of the
Cibola, at the crossing of the Marce
linus Creek a Cottonwood mark K. W.
on the west. Side of the Creek, at the
crossing on the San Antonio River
marked, on the East. Bank, of the
River, a Sycamore, tree K. W. on the
west. Bank, of the River, a large
Cottonwood marked K. W. and
others trees marked, X at the N. W.
corner, a Stake from which S 398 200
varies, is a mat of Sivo cutro with
old mark, for bearing
