Now comes W.J. Seale  
surveyor who was appointed to run  
the county line between Karnes & Goliad  
-d counties and files his report which  
was examined and adopted and ordered  
to be recorded in the Minutes of this Court  
and a certified copy be furnished  
to the Comrs of the Gen Land Office =

The State of Texas }  
County of Karnes } To the Honorable  
County Court of Karnes County  
Texas = Having been appointed by your  
Honorable body on the 12<sup>th</sup> Day of May  
1884 = To assist the surveyor of Goliad  
County to survey mark and establish  
the Boundary line between the Counties  
of Goliad and Karnes I proceeded to



the point designated by the Court to wit  
 the S.W. corner of DeWitt and the N.E.  
 corner of Goliad County on the Coleto  
 Creek on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1884 C. C.  
 Carstein was present to represent Golia  
 = d County and C. G. Hartman Co. Sur of  
 DeWitt was present to represent DeWitt  
 County = we found the original corner  
 made by Smith & Barnard the 22<sup>d</sup> of  
 August 1848 for the corner of DeWitt  
 and Goliad Counties which was midway  
 between two Live Oaks, one dead Mark  
 A and the other about 36 in dia Mark D.  
 W. the corner is about 100 yds from the  
 Coleto Creek on the S.W. side of the same  
 Thence we run S 67<sup>o</sup> W guiding the line  
 plainly marked every where there was  
 timber the surveyor of Goliad & DeWitt  
 took intersection of surveys which the  
 line crossed and placed Mounds & Post  
 at each mile marking bearing trees to  
 each Post & mound with letters of the Alpha  
 = bet - beginning with A & B it being in  
 = definite as to the proper place for the  
 corner of Karnes and DeWitt Counties  
 I kept correct count of the distance  
 from the Coleto Creek, and when we



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had placed the Twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) mile Post  
marking a Mesquite -  $L$   $S 23^{\circ} E 38$  vs me  
then considered the remainder of the line  
to be Established between Karnes & Goliad  
the Surveyor of De Witt Leaving us  
Thence  $S 57^{\circ} W$  at 1901 vs placed a Post  
and Mound in the field of Dick Yun  
= Linson whence we marked a Mesquite  
 $M$   $S 67^{\circ} W 327$  vs 2<sup>nd</sup> mile at 286 vs the  
center of the Lavasa Creek.  $S 14^{\circ} E 245$  from  
the west-corner of the Vicente Remus  
survey. and the S.E. Cor of the Antonio  
Lozgo at 1701 vs a Post & Mound whence  
a Mesquite  $N$  bis  $N 30^{\circ} W 90$  vs = 3<sup>rd</sup> mile  
at 1558 vs past the old line of De Witt and  
Goliad Counties made by Smith & Berna  
= rd at 1628 vs Road to Yorktown and  
Beville via Stibling crossing 1901 vs  
a Post & Mound no timber whence the  
old Cor. of De Witt & Goliad bis  $N 67^{\circ} E$   
 $343$  vs = 4<sup>th</sup> mile at 4 vs the Helena & Golia  
= d Road 115 vs a gully 1629 vs the center  
of a drain at 1901 vs a Mound & Post  
whence a Mesquit  $M$   $K$   $P$  bis  $N 83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$

 = nco Creek. the Boundary of Haines  
 & Bee counties we placed a Large  
 Mesquit-Post and raised an earth  
 Mound whence a L.O. MKd G bis S.  
 82° W 52<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> vs. and a L.O. 50 in Dia MKd  
 K bis N. 79° W 64 vs another L.O. MKd  
 S bis N 70° W 66<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> vs. and a L.O. 50 in  
 Dia MKd C O C bis S. 58° E 87 vs. and  
 another 20 in Dia MKd W. J. S bis S 35 E  
 77 vs. This corner stands S 19 E 390 and  
 N 57 E. 135 vs from the N.W. cor of the
