Dear Sir-

Our County Judge F. W. Schweppe has handed me your letter of Oct 12. 1893. Concerning the Boundary line between Kendall & Kerr Counties, and has requested me to write you on the subject - The accompanying sketch will show you the respective positions of the Starting points of the Surveys of 1880 & 1886 and the position of each line west of Comfort according to the Minutes of County Court on Record here - Both these surveys were made by the late D. W. Grady then Kendall Co Surveyor

I enclose also a map of the town of Comfort (one I have had at use in the field - hence its dirty appearance) that you may instruct me as to which public Square is meant by the Statute - since each survey calls for a course and distance ~~from~~ ^{to} the Centre of the Public Square and there are two public Squares

From the enclosed sketch it appears to me that the Western Square was adopted in 1880 which would make that line in accordance with your letter viz one mile West of the public square of Comfort - (A line due west from Comfort to strike the Guadalupe

River would be about 11. miles long (see Kerr Co Map)

The line of 1886 is 1181.15 to the East of that
of 1880 - and does not cross the ~~Quadrat~~
latitude of Comfort one mile west from the
Public ^{square} or any part of Comfort -

For your further information I beg to enclose also extract
of the Fieldnotes of the Surveys of A.D. 1880. & 1886. as
on record here -

The Commissioners Court meet here on Monday 12th
Feb: and I trust you may be able to send your
answer so that they can move in the matter during
their ~~next~~ ^{then} session - and instruct me to proceed -

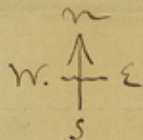
