RESOLUTION OF COMMISSIONERS COURT OF KENEDY COUNTY,
TEXAS, PASSED AT A SPECIAL MEETING OF SAID COURT HELD
ON THE 13th DAY OF September A. D. 1950

It was called to the attention of the Court that heretofore Lee H. Lytton, Jr., County Judge of Kenedy County, Texas, had authorized and directed Mr. F. G. French, County Surveyor of Kenedy County, Texas, in association with Mr. Charles S. Patterson, County Surveyor of Kleberg County, Texas, to survey and establish upon the ground the true boundary line between the Counties of Kenedy and Kleberg as to that part of such boundary line between such Counties defined and designated in the Report of such Surveyors, after making a survey upon the ground.

The Commissioners Court of Kenedy County, Texas, has now been furnished with such Report, which Report contains the field notes of the survey as made upon the ground, as surveyed by such County Surveyors, together with maps or plats outlining and establishing the true boundary line between the Counties of Kenedy and Kleberg.

A motion was thereupon made, duly seconded, and unanimously adopted by the Commissioners Court of Kenedy County, Texas, be it resolved as follows:

I.

That said Report of the County Surveyors of Kenedy and Kleberg Counties, Texas, be in all things, and it is hereby adopted, and that the line between such counties so established by them be and the same shall hereafter be the true line between Kenedy and Kleberg Counties, Texas as to that part of such line so surveyed and established by the County Surveyors of Kenedy and Kleberg Counties, Texas, as fully reflected in their Report, a copy of which Report and accompanying field notes and plat is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

DESCRIPTION OF A PORTION OF THE COUNTY LINE BETWEEN KLEBERG AND KENEDY COUNTIES,
TEXAS, BEING THAT PORTION OF THE LINE FROM WHERE THE MISSOURI-PACIFIC RAILROAD
CROSSES LOS OLMOS CREEK EASTWARD TO APPROXIMATELY LONGITUDE 97° 39'

Beginning at a point equa-distant from the vegetation lines on the north and south sides of the Los Olmos Creek and directly under the centerline of the Missouri-Pacific Railroad Bridge crossing said Los Olmos Creek. Said point is N 06° 19' 20" E 70.74 feet (25.47 varas) from U.S.C.&G.S. B.M. with brass plate in top stamped #P-47, 1917. Elevation 24.511 feet.

From said beginning point N 58° 22' 10" E 218.00 feet (78.48 varas) we set a 4" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate in top stamped REF. MARK. #1 KLEBERG-KENEDY. From this 4" iron pipe N 61° 19' 26" E 270.00 feet (97.20 varas) we set another 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate in top stamped REF. MARK. #2 KLEBERG-KENEDY.

From said beginning point under Railroad bridge thence easterly with the County Line meanders along the midpoints of Los Olmos Creek as established between vegetation lines:

to a County Line meander point from which we set a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate in top stamped REF. MARK. #3 KLEBERG-KENEDY, that bears S 51° 38' 31" E 151.55 feet (54.56 varas).

From said Reference Marker #3 N 86° 03' 10" E 689.15 feet (248.09 varas) we set a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate in top stamped REF. MARK. #4 KLEBERG-KENEDY; both of these reference markers being on high land on the south side of the Creek.

Thence continuing the County Line meanders:

N 65° 56' 49" E 710.82 feet (255.90 varas);

N 68° 19' 36" E 1325.11 feet (477.04 varas);

N 40° 44' 26" E 1147.98 feet (413.27 varas);

to a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass plate in top stamped COUNTY LINE MARK 5 KLEBERG-KENEDY which we set on a grassy knoll.

Thence N 83° 54' 15" E at 800.00 feet (288.00 varas) pass over a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate in top stamped COUNTY LINE AZ. MK. 6 KLEBERG-KENEDY which we set on the County Line and continuing on same bearing a total of 1000.00 feet (360.00 varas).

Thence S 20° 14' 44" E 1777.20 feet (639.79 varas);

S 68° 14' 44" E 2109.40 feet (759.38 varas);

N 81° 09' 22" E 2584.83 feet (930.54 varas);

S 14° 06' 56" E 1736.59 feet (625.17 varas);

S 27° 11' 47" E 3324.85 feet (1196.95 varas);

S 74° 32' 24" E 1217.67 feet (438.36 varas);

to a point in the mouth of Los Olmos Creek which is North 810.00 feet (291.60 varas) from a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with brass plate stamped REF. MARK. #8 KLEBERG-KENEDY set on high land. Said point also bears South 810.00 feet (291.60 varas) from

a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass plate stamped REF. MARK. #7 KLEBERG-KENNEDY which we set on a long low peninsula.

Thence continuing N $74^{\circ} 48' 25''$ E 27,266.93 feet (9816.09 varas) easterly across Laguna de los Olmos to a point which is N $00^{\circ} 23' 22''$ E 2791.67 feet (1005.00 varas) from a 6" iron pipe filled with concrete with a brass plate in top stamped REF. MARK. #9 KLEBERG-KENNEDY. From the 6" iron pipe filled with concrete U.S.C. & G.S. Triangulation Station Pasadio 1912, bears S $19^{\circ} 48' 25''$ E 5886.71 feet (2119.22 varas).

This last point on the County Line referenced by us is 2777.78 feet (1000.00 varas) north of the most northerly point of land in this vicinity.

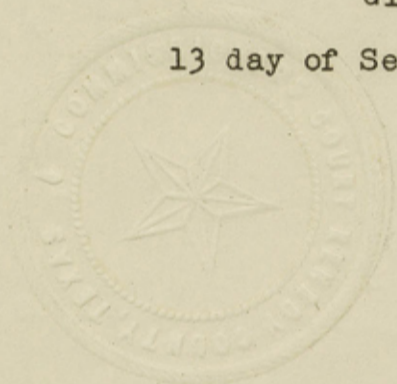
