Dear Sir:

In answer to your favor of 20th ult., will state, that county lines established and approved should be adopted and need not to be re-run or re-traced. The line of Stonewall County has to be run, together with the surveyor of said County, who has been instructed to adopt the established Dickens County S. E. corner for his starting point, in running the West line of his County.

The North line of Scurry County should be established with the aid of the Scurry County Surveyor from the established N. W. corner of Fisher County.

Scurry County had its lines run in 1885, but they were not approved, because they failed to connect the corners and lines with the corners of surveys.

If Garza County is not an organized County the Kent County Surveyor should run the line between said counties alone, and it will be approved, if otherwise made according to law. Full instructions and reference to the laws governing the running of county lines have been given before and this office does not care when and where the work is begun.
