County at a Stake from which a Baseline arc bns S $5\frac{1}{2}$ W
 $8\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. Another bns N $36\frac{1}{2}$ W $1\frac{1}{2}$ mrs.

Thence East with the Hanner and Nacogdoches Land
District line and the South line of Collin County 12 miles
and 141 varas to the West boundary line of Hunt County

Thence South 9 miles 1022 varas to the S.W. Corner of
Hunt County -

Thence East with the South line of Hunt County
13 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles to Stake from which the S.W. Corner of J. Roberts
Survey of 320 acres bns S $75\frac{1}{2}$ W 300 mrs.

Thence South 32 miles and 1500 varas to corner
point on the North boundary line of Henderson County
This corner is about 1500 varas South and 1500 varas East of
the N.E. corner of George Waters League Survey -

Thence West with the Henderson County line 21 miles
and 970 varas Stake in the East bank of Trinity River from
which the S.W. corner of G. Myers Survey No 23, and S.E. corner of
