Thence East with the Hannin and Nacog doches land
District line and the South line of Collin County 12 miles
and 141 varas to the West boundary line of Hunt County

Thence South 9 miles 1022 varas to the S.W. Corner of
Hunt County -

Thence East with the South line of Hunt County
 $13\frac{1}{2}$ miles to Stake from which the S.W. Corner of J. R. Stokes
survey of 320 acres bns $S 75^{\circ} W 300$ vs.

Thence South 32 miles and 1500 varas to Corner
point on the North boundary line of Henderson County
This Corner is about 1500 varas South and 1500 varas East of
