Thence East with the Fannin and Nacog-
doches land District line and the South
line of Collin County 12 miles and 141 varas
to the West boundary line of Hunt County,
Thence South 9 miles 1022 varas to the S. W.
corner of Hunt County, Thence East with
the South line of Hunt County, $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles
set stake from which the S. W. corner of
J. Roarks survey of 320 acres brs. S. 75 W.
 300 vs. Thence South 32 miles and 1500
varas to corner post on the North bound-
ary line of Henderson County, This cor-
ner is about 1500 varas South and 1500
varas East of the N. E. corner of George
Waters League Survey, Thence West
with the Henderson County line 21 miles
and 970 varas stake on the East bank
of Trinity River from which the S. W.
corner of A. Myers Survey No. 23 and
S. E. corner of A. Ables 320 acre Sur-
vey No. 25 brs. S. $83\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6600 varas, Thence
up Trinity River with its meanders
to the South line of Dallas County,
Thence East with the South line of
Dallas County to the S. E. corner of
said County, Thence North to the place

under my official oath that the line run-
ning between Kaufman & Collin Coun-
ties and the line running between Kauf-
man & West with Hunt County line was
run by James Smith in 1848 by order
of the County Court, and the South
line of Hunt County and the East line
of Kaufman County was run by R. H.
Turrill a Deputy Surveyor for the Mac-
ogoches Land District in 1848 and
the South line of Kaufman County
was run by me in 1848 and that the lines
boundaries and corners together with
the marks natural and artificial are
truly described therein. Witness my
hand this February 17th 1857.
