The State of Texas } To the Hon.  
Kaufman County } Commissioners  
Court of Kaufman.

Pursuant to a final agreement between  
special surveyor E. B. Ashurst of Rockwall  
county and myself to meet and deter-  
mine the line between Kaufman and  
Rockwall counties, on the first Monday  
in February A. D. 1883, I acting in  
obedience to an order from your Hon  
court, dated

A. D. 1880. On the said  
first Monday in February A. D. 1883, I went  
to the S. W. corner of Hunt county, and  
the surveyor of Rockwall failing to ap-  
pear, began the survey of the line di-  
viding said Rockwall and Kaufman  
Counties, which said line is describ-  
ed as follows: Beginning at the S. W.  
corner of Hunt county and running thence  
South at 710 vs N. E. line of E. Graves survey  
of 26 labors of land 1213 vs S 45 E from  
its North cor. at 1720 vs Timber Post oak  
16' dia 2 vs West of line at 1845 vs P. O. 10 dia

1<sup>st</sup> mile

At one mile erected monument from which  
a Post Oak 18 dia bears N 97 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 29 vs a post  
oak 20 in dia bears S 36 E 14 vs at 128 vs prairie

2<sup>d</sup> mile

At 2 miles erected monument from which  
a post oak 24' dia bears S 11 E 31 vs a  
Post Oak 17' dia bears S 76 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 35 vs West  
Thence West at 830 vs High Point creek

1<sup>st</sup> mile

At one mile erected monument in West

branch of Big High Point creek, no bearings near; at 400 vrs branch at 1580 vrs branch at 1660 vrs South end of a big tank of water.

2<sup>nd</sup> mile

At 2 miles erected a monument from which end of Mr Mudgett's house N20 W. at 440 vrs S.W. of E. Graves' survey 1110 from its West cor. and N.E. line of J. Cassillas' 31 vrs from its North cor. at 484 vrs S.E. line of E. A. Lloyd survey.

3<sup>rd</sup> mile

At 3 miles erected monument from which a tripple ash bears N88 1/2 W. 186 vrs at 80 vrs S.E. line of King Latham survey 1110 vrs from its North corner at 200 vrs branch

4<sup>th</sup> mile

At 4 miles erected monument just inside Mrs Whisholm's field near end Boisd' arc hedge at 35 vrs hedge at 1080 vrs Perry creek at 1820 vrs bend of Hackberry creek.

5<sup>th</sup> mile

At 5 miles erected monument 6 vrs North of said Hackberry creek from which an ash 18' dia bears N24 W. 1 1/2 vrs an Elm 8' dia bears N37 1/2 W. 1 vrs at 187 vrs Elm 18' on East bank of Hackberry creek at 194 vrs cross Hackberry creek at 200 vrs prairie at 370 vrs timber of Big Brushy creek at 395 vrs Elm 10' dia at 560 vrs cross Big Brushy creek at 660 vrs prairie

6<sup>th</sup> mile

At 6 miles erected monument from which M. M. Hall's brick chimney bears N54 1/2 W. and O. P. Thomas brick chimney S71 1/2 W. at 760 vrs S.W. line of King Latham survey 1110 vrs from West corner and N.E. line of Auth Peckham survey.

7<sup>th</sup> mile

At seven miles erected monument from which the East end of Judge Stevens house bears  $N77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$  and North end of Mrs Lee's house bears  $S9^{\circ}E$  at 431 vrs S.W. of A. J. Jones 1110 vrs from its East cor at 1572.

8<sup>th</sup> mile

At 8 miles erected monument on S.E. line of A. Rodrigues 1170 vrs from East cor. High prairie no bearing near, at 580 vrs branch at 610 vrs Elm 6' dia at 1195 vrs timber of little Buffalo creek at 1500 vrs cross little Buffalo creek

9<sup>th</sup> mile

At 9 miles erected monument in a field from which Mr. Fondren's "Well" bears  $N34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$  180 vrs at 182 brush 395 vrs Big Buffalo creek at 540 vrs tripple board arc at 740 vrs cross large slough Elm 14' at 840 vrs prairie, at 1160 vrs branch

10<sup>th</sup> mile

At 10 miles erected monument from which a hackberry 8' dia  $S64^{\circ}16'W$  73- at 1340 vrs branch between two farms

11<sup>th</sup> mile

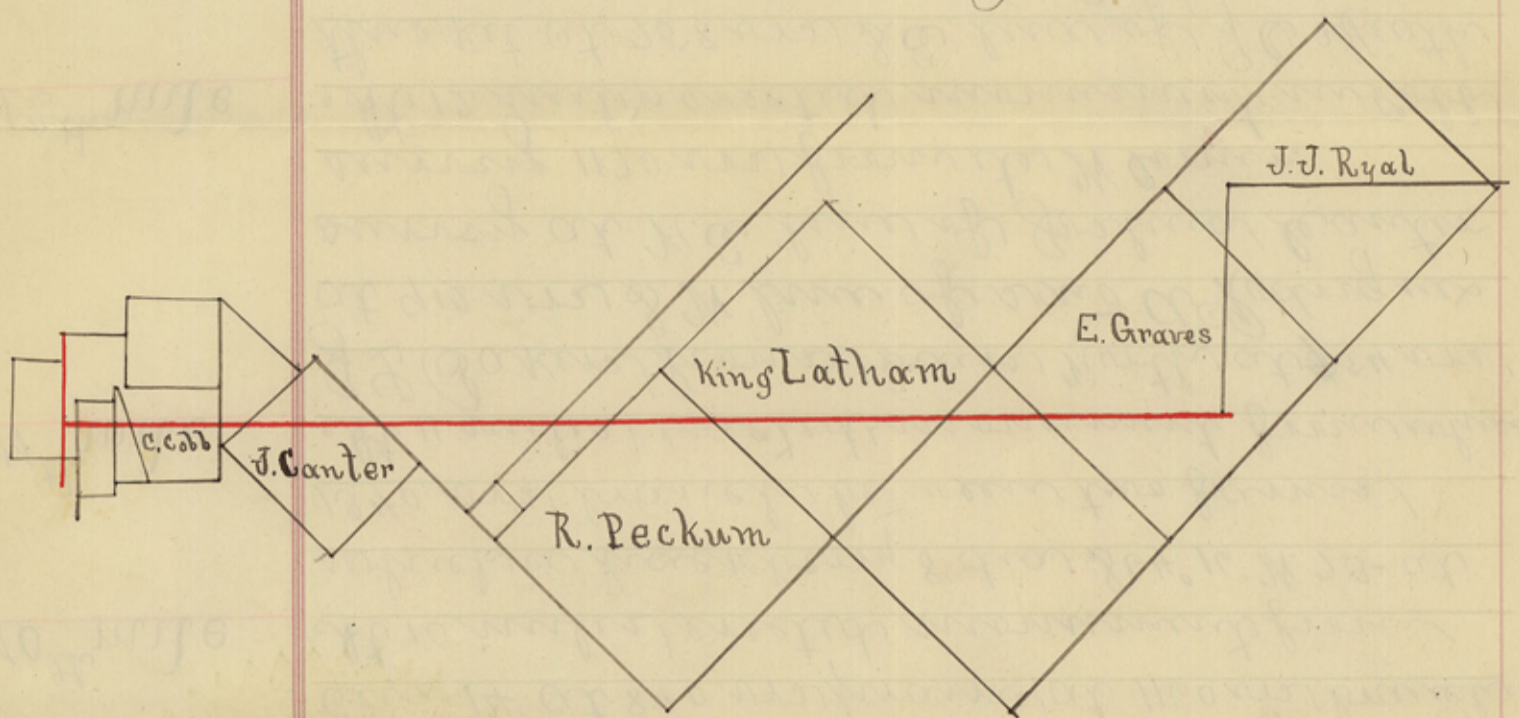
At 11 miles erected monument from which J. L. Baker's house bears North at 454 vrs at 912 vrs S.W. line of said A. Rodrigues survey at N.E. line of Joshua Canter survey 1170 vrs from its W corner.

12<sup>th</sup> mile

At 12 miles erected monument in Cobb thicket at 758 vrs S.E. line of J. C. Heath survey 1170 vrs from its East corner at 200 vrs small prairie, 300 vrs East line of Cobb survey 1000 vrs from S.E. corner at 1220 vrs East fork at 13 miles S.W. corner of Rockwall county 10 miles 961 vrs South of N.E. corner of Dallas county, erected monument from which a hackberry

10' dia bears N 57 1/2 W. 1 1/2 vrs Elm 10' dia  
bears S 59 E 7 vrs. Side lines marked  
4 haeks, line trees 4 haeks. Witness X
