 date Nov., Term A.D. 1891, meet H. Y. Kinney, Special Surveyor for Hunt
 County, on the day and at the place designated to me in said
 Order, to wit: on the 24th day of November A.D. 1891, and at the North
 East Corner of Kaufman County, as located by L. H. Bryant in
 the year A.D. 1883, then Special Surveyor of this County, for that
 purpose. At this point we disagreed. I proposed to commence at
 this said North East corner and run west with the line made
 by the said L. H. Bryant, putting the same as the Law directs.
 To this the said H. Y. Kinney, Special Surveyor, did then and there
 object; claiming to begin at the place designated by him
 as the South East corner of Hunt County, as originally made;
 to this I could not consent to do: therefore no survey was
 made by us, to locate said line. I will here state, that the
 said Surveyor from Hunt Co., did at the time we were
 at the said North East corner, admit that it was the corner
 made by L. H. Bryant in the year 1883, and that the line run
 by him was there; but claiming that the same was not correct;
 but that the said corner and line was south of this place,
 about $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles. I will here state that at the said North East
 corner there is a small mound, about six inches above the
 surface of the ground; and that the trees called for is there.
 From this corner I ran, west with line, which can be traced
 with compass & chain, though very dim, I found no monuments
 as the Law directs, except what is given at the said N.E. corner.
 I found at the end of each mile run, trees marked H. Y. K.
 I will here state, that 1 mile S 44^o W or south of the said North East
 corner, I found a small mound, and witness trees which is
 also called the North East corner of Kaufman County by

by the said L. H. Bryant, in locating the N & S line between the Counties of Kaufman & Wanyandt, in company with the Surveyor of Wanyandt Co. in the year 1850, by order of Jury from said Counties, as shown by the Records of this County.

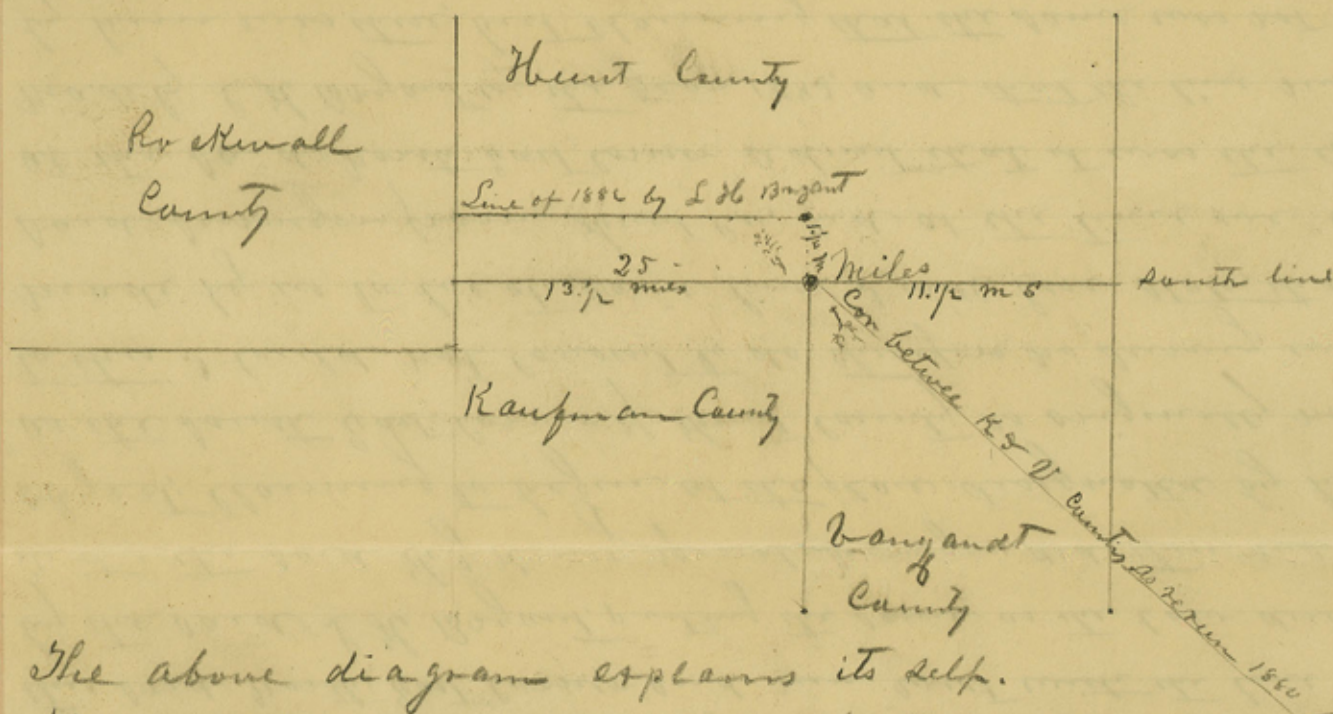
