To the Commissioner of the Land Office
State of Texas.

In the Matter of controversy be-
tween the County of Hunt and Kaufman
as to the true position of the County
boundary separating the respective
Counties, I find upon examination
of the Original South boundary line
of Hunt County that the line appears
to have been established with care
and accuracy calling for natural
objects and giving course and distance
from same to the lody line and the
mile posts established

I have also compared the County
line of said Hunt and Kaufman Coun-
ties as recently retraced and submitted
by Hely Kincy Special Surveyor for Hunt
County, with the Original County lody
of said Hunt Co. on file in this office
and find the natural objects with
bearing trees &c to be identical for
course and distance as described
in the original field notes of said
lody established by M H Wright in
1846.

I have examined the original N lody
lines of Kaufman and Van Zandt
Counties on file in this office and
find that each County lody has the
identical call for course and dis-
tance from the S W Cor of the

Roark Sur. of 320 acres and
that Van Zandt Co ~~has~~ recogni-
zes the original ~~& E~~ ^W ~~of~~ Hunt
Co established in 1846 as a point
on said boundary line of Van Zandt
and no change in said line of
Van Zandt has been made or recog-
nized by ^{said Co or} this department still ad-
hering to the original ^{line} of said County
as originally filed in this Office.

The Statutes require the N & E cor
of Kaufman and the N W Cor of
Van Zandt to be identical and
each call for the south bounda-
ry line of Hunt County.

The above facts being a matter
of record in this department
as prescribed by the laws reg-
ulating County boundaries
they are respectfully submit-
ted for your consideration
for determining the correct
boundary line that separates
the County of Hunt from the
County of Kaufman whether
the line established in 1846
by Mr St Wright or the line estab-
lished in 1882 by S St Bryant
is the true line in the mean-
ing and intent of the decision
of the Supreme Court. Jones vs Pow-
