Dear sir:-

I have your letter of recent date stating that yu you would not be able to make a correct abstract from the field notes of Lamb County Line as surveyed by me last May 1910. I have refered this letter to the Commissioner's Court of Lamb County and they state that they want the field notes made in such a man= ner as will be sufficient and satisfactory for you to make the revised abstract of surveys in each of the counties. I have other work in Lamb county soon so will make forther surveys and deter-

mine the League and section corners as near as I possible can.

Refering to the map of the N.S.& W.boundary lines field nots of Lamb county as made by me you will note that there is a Halsell Subdivision in the North part of Lamb County and the South part of Castro county. I wish to know wether it will be necassary for me to connect section and League corners of surveys alongt this portion of the County line? Will it be sufficient to get the League Corners nearest to line and on both side of the County line. I will survey some of the Capitol Leagues in the southern portion of the county on both North and South sides of the County line and make a systematic survey so it will give very correct connections to County line. I would like well to survey the East line of Lamb County but have not been able to get the commissioner's Court of Lamb County to let me do this. Perhap you had better write up there and advise them of this fact as it will be necessary before they can get a complete revised abstract of surveys along County line.
