Dear Sir,

Your fax of the 22^d in regard
to the line between this & Coryell County, just to hand
On notice last year from the Co Judge of
Coryell Co of intentions to run said line I appoin-
ted our Co Surveyor, to meet on the day & place
designated the Coryell Surveyor - & to run & follow
the line, as the law requires, he went on the
day to the ^{stake} point but the Coryell Surveyor did
not meet, but after came over the line in
absence of our Surveyor & placed up the required
posts. I got our Surveyor to examine said
line so run by Coryell Surveyor. And he reported
that the line had ^{been} properly run & fix'd as was
right & as always claimed by this County - whereupon
on receipt of our Surveyors report I wrote to the
County Judge of Coryell that Lamparas Co
was satisfied with the line as run & establish'd
by her Surveyor under his order & that on

the part of Sarnepians - we accepted in
the could so reports as to make it a
finality and save further costs

So if it can be done I here give the agent
of Sarnepians to adopt said line as
done under order of Judge Ruby of
Coryell last year. So that the lines
on future maps may show it. And the
citizens on what was formerly the disputed
territory may not be troubled with argument
in both Counties. This year I believe they
have been opened in both Counties.

If any further action be necessary
you will much oblige me by letting
me hear from you.
