

To The Honorable Commissioners Court  
of Lampasas County

In pursuance of your order of  
March 1<sup>st</sup> 1883. to survey the line be-  
tween this <sup>and</sup> Coryell County I would  
beg leave to submit the following as  
my report. Beginning at a Live Oak  
on a mountain 582 varas N 30 E  
from the N.E. corner of G. J. Benson  
160 acre Survey. This being same Live  
Oak described in former field notes  
of this line as having 5 chaps on 2  
sides & which I marked L C B. Then  
S. 30 E at 100 vs a stone monument  
on bluff brow of mountain at 200  
vs a deep ravine at 300 a monument  
at 1 mile a stone set 262 varas N 71 E  
from Sam Sned N.E. corner at 1 mile  
& 475 varas a stone marked L set on  
East side of Hamilton & Lampasas  
road at 1 mile & 1425 vs a stone mon-  
ument on a mountain at 2 miles a  
monument at 2 miles 1150 vs pass  
50 feet E of That Petrusa house at 3  
miles a stone marked L at 4 miles  
a monument from which the N W  
corner of H Richter bears S 52 W 85 vs  
and a Live Oak marked H b/s N 52 1/2 E 15  
vs at 4 1/2 miles a large stone marked  
L at 5 miles a stone marked L at  
5 1/2 miles a stone set in a line of  
Richter survey 787 vs N 71 E from the

N.W. corner of same at 6 miles <sup>and</sup> 300  
was a stone marked L from which the  
S.E. corner of H Richter Survey No 3 bears  
N 71 E 30 varas <sup>and</sup> an Elm S 88 W 3 was  
at 7 miles a stone monument on point  
of mountain at the head of Bee house  
creek at 8 miles a stone monument  
from which a post oak marked L  
bears E 4 or dist at 8½ miles a stone  
marked L in head of mountain Gulch  
this stone I found already marked at  
same former survey of this line at 9  
miles a Live Oak marked L standing by  
an old fallen down rock chimney (I  
take this to be the Higgins old place  
over the mountain) at 10 miles a rock  
marked L at 11 miles a monument  
on a mountain near the N.W. corner  
of Kauken Survey at 12 miles a  
stone marked 14 set on south bank  
of a branch about 1200 ft E from  
Higgins Gap. at 13 miles a stone mark  
ed 15 set in Abrams N line 321 or  
N 71 W from his N.E. corner at 14  
miles a small chalk hill 180 ft N 45  
E from J R Watson's N.E. corner at  
15 miles stone marked L 7 at 16.  
miles a Large Live oak marked 19  
400 ft west of Gentles old House at  
17 miles an Elm marked L G on south  
bank of Table rock creek at 18 miles  
a stone monument in the prairie at

19 miles a mulberry tree marked  
X & W.M & 10 chops all made at some  
previous survey. This is in the prairie  
about  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles west of the Arnold  
place and near the Gatesville road and  
400 ws E of A Swords NW corner. at  
20 miles a rock marked L at 21  
miles found a rock lying in prairie  
marked GCL on 1 side which I set  
& marked on the other side LCL  
at  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile S 30 E of this rock I passed  
between 2 round Hills or mountains  
at 22 miles rocks piled at root of a  
post oak marked L & 5 chop<sup>o</sup> at 23  
miles a live marked L <sup>and</sup> 5 chop<sup>o</sup> on 2  
sides at 24 miles a stone at the  
west end of a Hill. at 400 ws past  
this point line passes 100 feet west  
of a new school house on head wa-  
ters of Taylors creek at 25 miles a  
Live Oak marked L & has J M<sup>o</sup>  
McLane cut in letters round the  
tree 26 miles an old dilapidated  
stone wall at an old deserted set-  
tlement in mountain core. at 27  
miles a monument on a mountain  
at head of Taylors creek. at 28  
miles a stone marked X at 29 miles  
a Live Oak marked X <sup>and</sup> 5 chops on  
2 sides. at 30 miles a stone round  
in prairie glade. at 31 miles & 200 ws  
a large monument in the west

line of Bell County. Survey of this  
line began on the morning of  
May 30<sup>th</sup> and ending on the even-  
ing of June 4<sup>th</sup> 1883. Vara 10° E
