

Ordered that the time fixed by this Court on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1887 for surveying the line between Lampasas <sup>and</sup> Hamilton County be changed from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> of August 1887 and the <sup>County</sup> Surveyor of this County is hereby directed to notify the surveyor of Hamilton County of said change.

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the boundary line between Lampasas County and Hamilton County beginning at the North East Corner of said Lampasas County and extending to the South West Corner of said Hamilton County is not sufficiently specified and well ascertained: It is therefore ordered that E Brown County Surveyor of Lampasas County proceed and ascertain, survey and mark out said boundary line and that he begin at said North East Corner of Lampasas County on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1887 and survey thence South 60° West to the South West Corner of Hamilton County and the said E Brown surveyor as aforesaid with or without the assistance of the person appointed by the Commissioners Court of Hamilton County to assist in running said line having marked out and designated said line as required by this order, shall then proceed to ascertain and establish the true location of the South East Corner of the merged County of Mills as designated in the law creating said County of Mills, and having so ascertained and established the true location of said S. E. corner of Mills County, said E Brown

shall then, without making an actual survey, map out and sketch a line beginning at said S. E. Corner of Mills County and running, thence South 56° West to the Colorado River. Specifying in said map and sketch the true location of said line on all the most important surveys it crosses in its course to the Colorado River.

Ordered further that <sup>W</sup>E Brown make his report to this Court as early as practicable after performing said service.

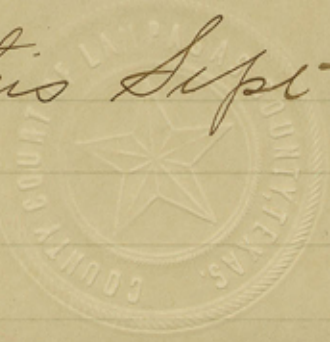
