

Field notes &c Plot of boundary line between Lampasas
and Burnet Counties -

It appearing to the court that the Boundary
Line between Lampasas and Burnet Counties
is not sufficiently definite and well defin-
ed, It is therefore Ordered by the Court that E.
Brown Surveyor of Lampasas County Texas.
be and he is hereby appointed and authorized
to proceed to ascertain by actual survey and
legally mark the "Boundary Line" between Lam-
pasas & Burnet Counties. Beginning at the
upper corner of the Sallie House (widow of
James House) League number fourteen (14) on
the Colorado River, Thence East to a point
A 30° West from the point on the Lampasas River
where the lower line of the W P Rease survey
crosses the same, said survey to be made, run
Established and marked according to Law.

It is further ordered by the Court that E Brown
Surveyor as aforesaid proceed to make said
survey on the 19th day of May 1890 at 12
o'clock noon and to co-operate with any person
duly appointed by the proper authority of Bur-
net County and reporting to assist in said
work. It is further ordered by the Court that
a certified copy of this order be sent to the
County Court of Burnet County Texas.

In obedience to and Compliance with the above
and foregoing order I proceeded to the N.W. corner
of the Jas House League Survey No 14 on the
Colorado River and was there at 12 o'clock noon

May 19th 1890 to begin the survey as ordered, No one appearing from Burnet County to co-operate and assist in said survey I proceeded to qualify chain Beams and make the survey according to article 691 a - Beginning at the N.W. corner of the Jas House Survey No 14 as established at Goat Head Bluff on E Bank of the Colorado River by the Burnet County Surveyors, I proceeded to meander down the river forming the S.W. corner of the Jas House survey as established with 1 L.S. Bearing NNE 45° this making said survey 2610 vs between its N.E. & S. lines instead of 2030 vs as called for in its field notes, I then proceeded down the river with my chain Beams and guides to the lower line of the Fidrick McKnight survey No 9 the S.W. corner of this survey, being sufficiently definite, I proceeded to run East along an ancient wall defined line on which is built a Post and wire fence at 2850 vs I proceeded to run North at 2638 vs the N.B. line of said McKnight survey. Then at 1892 vs the common line between the two Fidrick McKnight surveys line well defined Then at 1800 vs the N.B. line of the upper McKnight survey line anciently marked. Then at 1343 vs the N.B. line of the Asa Fowler Survey a well defined line anciently marked. Then at 950 vs the S.B. line of the Jas House survey No 14 as established by and surveyed from by all the previous Surveyors of Burnet County.

as shown by their placing the N corner of the
two Townships & a part of Jones' Survey said line.
Thence N at 26° vs the N.B. Line of the Jas House
Survey N^o 14 as established by surveyors Moliney
Moses & Chamberlain of Burnet County. This
line is just 22800 farther North than the Field notes
of the surveys from the F M Knight lower line
up north call for said line to be. But all of Burnet
County surveyors having agreed on this line and
having had Land "patented" from said line.
I thought it just right and proper to move
up to this point giving Burnet County an
Ecess of 228 vs from the lower line of the
Fodrick M Knight Surv N^o 9.

Here I established the S.W. Cor of Lampson's County
Thence W. along an ancient and well defined
line variation 9° E at 5700 vs a st and thc N.W.
corner of the Jas House Surv N^o 14 on Goat Head
Bluff on east Bank of the Colorado River which
bears at this point N 55-11. by S 05 E. a deep
Gulch 136 vs.

Thence East (variation 9° E) along the North brink of
a deep Gulch at 360 vs top of mountain old line
marks; here I began to blaze and make two hocks
above and two below the blaze to denote County line
at 1110 vs a deep hollow at 1900 vs set 1st Mile Stone
a rock monument marked on top L & B Co Line
1 mile East C.R. Thence East at 1080 vs thc S.E.
corner of J C Withrow and S.W. corner of Sec N^o
32 G C & S F R R Co lots S. 3 vs at 1900 vs Set
2nd Mile Stone marked L & B 2 Ms E. C.R. from
