It is therefore ordered that said survey made by said T. J. Hardeman be rejected and that said T. J. Hardeman be ordered to refund to J. W. D. Day Co. Treas. Lampasas Co. Texas. the sum of One hundred and thirty five dollars (\$135<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) the said amount having been advanced to him on said survey, and in case said T. J. Hardeman fails to meet and make satisfactory with this Court at its next regular term. Ordered that the County Attorney be and is hereby instructed to bring suit on his bond for above amount.
