1 In the matter of the County ~~of~~ July Term of County Court.
2 Lines of Lampasas County July 11th A.D. 1899.

3 This day, County Court being in session at its regular
4 July Term A.D. 1899, & it appearing to the satisfaction
5 of the Court, that the N.W. corner of Lampasas County
6 & the S.W. corner of Hamilton County, they being
7 the same corner, is indefinite & not well defined,
8 & in order to definitely determine & define the
9 location of said corner it is necessary for the surveyor
10 hereby appointed to begin his survey at the S.E. corner
11 of Hamilton County on the north line of Coryell County,
12 which corner is well established & perfectly defined,
13 & it is so ordered. Thence to run S. 60 W. from said
14 S.E. corner of Hamilton County, passing the N.W. corner
15 of Coryell County which is the N.E. corner of Lampasas
16 County to point of intersection with the East-line of
17 Mills County, for the S.W. corner of Hamilton County
18 & upper N.W. corner of Lampasas County.

19 And it further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court
20 that the boundary line between Lampasas &
21 Hamilton Counties is not sufficiently definite &
22 well defined but is on the contrary insufficiently
23 defined & wholly indefinite.

24 Therefore it is the duty of this Court under
25 Article 799 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas
26 to appoint an experienced & competent surveyor whose
27 duty it shall be in connection with a surveyor
28 appointed by the County Court of Hamilton County, if
29 any be by said Court appointed, & if not, or if said
30 Surveyor so appointed does not attend, then alone
31 to ascertain by actual survey the boundary line
32 & corner hereinbefore mentioned & set forth, which

1 are, as aforesaid, not sufficiently definite & well
2 defined, & to make & establish said line & corner in
3 the manner prescribed in Chapter Four Title XXIII. of
4 the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas, after making
5 Oath & Bond as therein provided.

6 Now therefore, premises considered, it is by the
7 Court-ordered that V. N. Jivley an experienced &
8 competent surveyor, be, & he is hereby appointed as
9 under Chapter Four, Title XXIII of the Revised
10 Statutes of Texas, surveyor to survey, as provided
11 in said Chapter, the boundary above & heretofore
12 described & to establish the corner afore mentioned,
13 & the said V. N. Jivley appointed as aforesaid, is
14 hereby authorized, empowered, & commanded, after
15 making Oath & Bond provided by law to proceed
16 on Tuesday the 17th day of October 1899, from that
17 point to wit: The S. E. corner of Hamilton County
18 on the North line of Coryell County, which is well &
19 definitely established, & then in connection with the
20 Surveyor appointed by the County Court of Hamilton
21 County, if any there appear so appointed, & if not
22 then alone to proceed to ascertain by actual survey
23 & measurement the S. W. corner of Hamilton County,
24 which is the N. W. corner of Lampasas County on the
25 East line of Mills County. Having ascertained the
26 true location of said corner, it shall be established
27 by Post, Mound or Stone monument, & if by Post,
28 it shall be of Hewn Cedar, Cypress or Box's' core, at
29 least eight inches in diameter, five feet long, & set
30 in the ground at least three feet, & if said corner
31 be a mound said mound shall be of stone if
32 practicable, otherwise of earth not less than two

1 feet high. He the said V. N. Zivley, in connection
2 with the surveyor appointed by the County Court
3 of Hamilton County, if any such there be, if not,
4 alone, is hereby authorized empowered & commanded
5 to run, locate & determine the true boundary line
6 between Lampasas & Hamilton Counties, & at the
7 end of each mile so run, by him or them there shall
8 be established a like Post, mound or monument
9 as established at said S. W. corner of Hamilton
10 County, it being the N. W. corner of Lampasas County
11 on the East line of Mills County.

12 The Field Notes of the Boundary line of Lampasas &
13 Hamilton Counties, that is to say the line between
14 the two Counties of Lampasas & Hamilton, shall
15 give an accurate description of all prominent
16 natural objects crossed by or adjacent to said line,
17 as well as the points at which survey lines are crossed,
18 & shall also give the distance from the said County
19 boundary line to the nearest corner or corners of all
20 surveys, tracts or parcels of land bisected by said
21 County boundary, in order that the acreage
22 belonging to each County may be properly computed.

23 The said V. N. Zivley shall make due return of said
24 Field Notes, together with plot of same, & when
25 received by the Clerk of this Court shall be recorded
26 & a certified Copy filed in the General Land Office.
27 And should the said V. N. Zivley, herein appointed,
28 having surveyed said line or any part thereof in
29 connection with a Surveyor appointed by the County
30 Court of Hamilton County, & failing to agree as to the
31 true boundary line between the Counties respectively
32 appointing them, then the facts of such disagreement,

1 with a full statement of the questions at issue
2 between them shall be by him reported to the
3 Commissioner of the General Land Office.

4 The said surveyor shall be allowed the sum of
5 three dollars per mile for each mile of County
6 Boundary line run in accordance with this order,
7 & two dollars per mile for connecting lines of land
8 surveys etc. The Clerk of this Court is hereby
9 ordered to prepare at once a certified copy of this
10 order, & transmit same by registered mail to the
11 County Court of Hamilton County.
