Dear Sir:

Recently received a letter from you stating that you were thinking of recognizing the North line as the true boundary line between Webb County on the South and LaSalle County on the North and disregard the Mills line which is the South line between said two Counties. The Mills line I have every reason to believe is the true one and the mistake in establishing the other line was a surveyor's mistake in counting up his distance, leaving out one big "out" making about a mile difference. Hon. Frank H. Burmeister has done surveying there and he tells me he discovered this mistake that caused the North line of the boundary line to be established and he says the Mills line is the correct line. Our friends in Encinal want to stay in LaSalle County and if you should change the abstract numbers as indicated by you it would put them in Webb County which none of us desire.

I understand that Webb County officials are perfectly satisfied that the Mills line is the correct ~~one~~ <sup>North</sup> and hence it seems to me that all necessary would be to have ~~the~~ <sup>North</sup> Commissioners Court agree that the Mills line be re-surveyed and field notes sent in and recorded. If so please let me know and am satisfied we can get this agreement and get this done. If this is not all necessary please advise me what should be done and greatly oblige,
