

1 To the Hon Hall Law Commissioner of  
2 the State of Texas.

3 Your petitioner the County of Webb by her  
4 Attorneys Dovo & Pierce, by to make this  
5 formal protest against the adoption of any  
6 Survey of the South Boundary line of LaSalle  
7 County, made in pursuance of an order  
8 of the Commissioners Court of LaSalle County  
9 passed November 9<sup>th</sup> 1886. Directing one  
10 Thomas Braud Surveyor of LaSalle  
11 County to make said Survey in accord-  
12 ance with said order, beginning on December  
13 6<sup>th</sup> and concluding said Survey on December  
14 12<sup>th</sup> 1886. And for cause show-

15 First! That a copy of said order with except  
16 for service was made Nov. 27<sup>th</sup> 1886. And was not  
17 served upon J.M. Rodriguez County Judge of  
18 Webb County, the County to which Euzinal  
19 County is attached for judicial purposes  
20 till November 29<sup>th</sup> 1886. And only seven  
21 days prior to the date upon which said  
22 Surveyor was to begin to survey and ~~mark~~  
23 said boundary. And that therefore any Survey  
24 made is without authority of law, is null  
25 and void. See R.S. 687.

X Second. Because said Southern boundary  
26 line of LaSalle County, was in accordance  
27 with the provisions of Chapter four title  
28 Revised Statutes of Texas; and in accordance  
29 with an order of the Commissioners Court  
30 of LaSalle County, duly served upon the  
31 County Judge of Webb County, the County

1 to which Incinal was there & is now attached  
2 for judicial purposes, wrought and the said  
3 boundary specified and marked by the person  
4 designator by said order of the Commissioners  
5 Court of said LaSalle County, which field  
6 notes defining & marking said boundary so made  
7 by the person thus designated by the Commissioners  
8 aforesaid, was at a regular meeting of the  
9 Commissioners Court of said LaSalle County  
10 ratified confirmed and adopted on November  
11 16<sup>a</sup> 1881.

12 Thirdly Because the adoption of the survey  
13 field notes & marking and defining the  
14 said boundary in 1881, in accordance with  
15 Chapter 4- Title 21 Revised Statutes of Texas  
16 and the acquiescence of the other Counties  
17 interested therein, stops the County of  
18 LaSalle from changing altering or amending  
19 said boundary line.

20 Fourthly. Said line so made in 1881, has  
21 been & is now the recognized boundary  
22 between said LaSalle & Incinal, & is so  
23 recognized by our Courts as the proper  
24 political division of said Counties.

25 Therefor the County of Webb to which Incinal  
26 is attached respectfully urges her protest  
27 against any change or alteration of said  
28 line.
