Field Notes of the County line of Leon and  
Madison Counties from Navasota River to  
the S.W. corner of the Alse Garrett League.  
Beginning at the corner of Leon, Madison,  
Brazos and Robertson Counties at a Cedar  
Post, marked with the initials of said counties,  
standing in what used to be the channel  
of Navasota River, as I was informed.

Thence N. 66 E. at 1110 vs. cross Navasota River  
at 1900 vs. set the first Post on the old San  
Antonio Road, near the south line of the  
Joseph Mc Dougald 370 acre survey.

Thence with that line N. 70 E. 700 vs. to the S.W.  
corner of A. Copeland 20 Labor survey, a stake on  
the north side of said Road for corner (A 1  
timber near). Thence with the south

line of the said Copeland survey, and the  
meanders of said <sup>Agad</sup> Road N. 84  $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 390 vs., N. 82  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 265 vs.  
and N. 62 E. 495 vs. set the second Post, continue  
the same course 1025 vs. further to next mean-

der. Thence N. 64  $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 875 vs. set the third Post,  
continue same course 555 vs. further to next

meander. Thence N. 77 E. <sup>at</sup> 1132 vs. cross a  
branch, at 1140 vs. the S.E. corner of said  
Copeland survey and the S.W. corner of the  
S. Lester <sup>survey</sup> a stake, whence P.C. 10 in. dia. brs  
N. 80 W. 4 vs.

Thence with the south line of  
said Lester survey and meanders of said Road  
N. 82 E. 205 vs. set the 4<sup>th</sup> Post continue same  
course 565 vs. further to next meander.

Thence S 82 E. 230 vs., N. 68 E. 320 vs., N. 55 E. 630 vs and  
N. 60 E. 155 vs. set the 5<sup>th</sup> Post, continue same course  
27 vs. further to the S.E. corner of said Lester survey  
and the S.W. corner of the R. Morris 820 acre  
survey, a stake, whence a P.C. 12 in. dia. brs N. 29  
W. 5 vs. and P.C. 10 in dia. brs S. 48 W. 7 vs.

Thence with south line of said Morris Survey and the meanders of said road N. 45 E. 900 vs., N. 50 E. 210 vs., to the S. E. corner of the said Morris survey, and the S. W. corner of the B. F. Whitaker League, a stake, whence a P.D. 30 in dia br. N. 2 E. 180 vs. Thence with the south line of said Whitaker League along said old road N. 57 1/2 E. at 763 vs. set the 6<sup>th</sup> Post at 930 vs cross branch at 1020 vs. cross another branch at 2020 vs enter Prairie at 2663 vs set the 7<sup>th</sup> Post, at 3925 vs. cross another branch, at 4563 vs set the 8<sup>th</sup> Post at 5100 vs the S. E. corner of said Whitaker and S. W. corner of Rott Rogers Leagues, a rock and a stake for corner. Thence with the south line of said Rogers League along said Road N. 55 E. at 1363 vs set 9<sup>th</sup> Post, at 3263 set The 10<sup>th</sup> Post, at 5101, the S. E. corner of said Rogers League and the S. W. corner of the Mark Copeland League a rock for corner in the mouth of a lane.

Thence with the south line of said Copeland League along said old Road N. 52 1/2 E. at 63 vs set the 11<sup>th</sup> Post, at 1963 vs set the 12<sup>th</sup> Post at 3863 vs set the 13<sup>th</sup> Post, at 4050 leave the Prairie, at 4520 vs cross Caney or Copeland Creek, continue same course 580 vs. further come to the S. E. corner of said Copeland League, and the S. W. corner of the M. B. Thomas 1/4 League, a stake, whence an Elm br. S. 45 W. 71 vs. Thence with the south line of said 1/4 League along said Road N. 82 E. at 663 vs set the 14<sup>th</sup> Post, at 960 cross a branch at 2140 vs the S. E. corner of said Thomas 1/4 League and the S. W. corner of James Riley League on the north side of said old Road, a stake, whence a dead hickory br. N. 35 E. 40 vs. Thence with the south line of said Riley League and S. W. corner of The A. C. Bullock League, along the north

side of said old Road N. 63<sup>o</sup>E at 423 vs. set the  
15<sup>th</sup> Post, at 2323 vs. set 16<sup>th</sup> Post, at 4223 vs. set  
the 17<sup>th</sup> Post, continue the same course  
877 vs. come to the S.E. corner of said Riley  
League, a stake, whence a B. J. stump 20 in  
dia. brs. N. 74<sup>o</sup>E 96 vs. Thence with South line  
of said Bullock League N. 10<sup>o</sup>E at 1023 set the 18<sup>th</sup>  
Post, continue the same course 1600<sup>vs</sup> further  
come to S.E. corner of said Bullock League and  
the S.W. corner of the Alse Garrett League set  
the 19<sup>th</sup> Post for corner on said old Road. Said  
Post are all marked on the Leon County side  
with the letters L.C. and the opposite side with  
the letters M.C. with Green Paint. That the  
distance from the beginning corner to the S.W.  
corner of the Garrett League is eighteen miles  
and 1600 vs (18 Miles and 1600 vs).

Leon County B 13<sup>th</sup> day of July AD 1901

This day came on to be heard the report of James A. Brown County Surveyor of Leon County Specially appointed and duly qualified to ascertain by actual Survey on the ground the County line between Leon and Madison Counties from the South West Corner thereof to the S. N. Corner of the Alice Garnett League and to establish the lines and corners thereof. And it appearing to the Court that said Surveyor was duly appointed by this Court by an order entered on the docket and minutes thereof on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January AD 1901 and that on the day of AD 1900 he was duly qualified to enter upon the duties incumbent on him by virtue of said appointment by giving the bond and taking the oath prescribed by law and that a certified copy of the order of this Court made and entered on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January AD 1901 as aforesaid was sent to the County Court of Madison County which convened for the March Term AD 1901 of said Court on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday it being the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March AD 1901 and was served on the County Judge of said Madison County on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March AD 1901 and that the said County Court of Madison County Texas failed and refused to appoint an experienced and competent practical Surveyor or in fact any Surveyor to assist in running and establishing said line It is therefore

ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court  
that the said report of the said James A.  
Brown Surveyor as aforesaid be and  
the same is hereby approved and confirmed  
and that the clerk record said said report  
together with the field notes and map of  
said County line and that a certified  
copy of this decree together with said  
report, field notes and map be returned  
by said clerk to the general land office

In the County Court of Leon County  
To the Honorable J. W. Powell County Judge of Leon County  
Texas. The undersigned County Surveyor of Leon County duly  
qualified, appointed at <sup>the</sup> January Term 1901 of said Court  
on the part of said County, by an order made at said term  
and entered on the minutes of said Court, to survey and ~~run~~  
to run the line between Leon and Madison Counties, on the old  
Lawtonia and Nachitoches Road, from the corner <sup>of</sup> said Counties  
on the N. W. corner of the Alse Garrett League,  
and to put up cedar Posts at the end of each mile, the Posts be  
five <sup>feet</sup> long and <sup>at</sup> least eight inches in diameter, to be put three  
feet in ground to be sawed or hewed.

The undersigned Surveyor begs leave to report to your Honor that  
said order required him to commence the work on the 25<sup>th</sup> of  
March 1901 and to complete it and report on or before the  
8<sup>th</sup> day of April 1901, that he was not informed of said order

the work was to  
commenced, that on the 25<sup>th</sup> of March 1901, he being unwell,  
sent his son H. H. Brown a qualified ~~Deputy~~ Surveyor, on the  
premises, to meet the Madison County Surveyor, if one should  
be sent, and to commence the work. That the time was too  
short after he got ~~the~~ the notice to get the Posts and do the work,  
and that upon his application your Honor extended the  
time sixty days, by an order entered on the minutes of said  
Court.

That on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1901 he went with  
said H. H. Brown and other help and commenced the survey  
and on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May 1901 finished the work on the ground,  
that the 19<sup>th</sup> <sup>the Post</sup> was put <sup>at</sup> the S. W. corner of the Alse Garrett League  
and only 1600 varas from the 18<sup>th</sup> Post. The Posts are all marked  
on the Leon County side with the Letters L. C. and on the op-  
posite side M. C. with Green Paint. That the distance from  
the ~~beginning~~ beginning corner to the S. W. corner of the Garrett League  
is eighteen miles and 1600 varas. That the Posts are set on and  
near the South lines of the Leon County surveys, that the accom-  
panying field notes and Plat is a correct representation of the
