Dear Sir:

In doing the field work of establishing the County line between Lipscomb and Ochiltree Counties, the undersigned Rupert C. Allen, surveyor representing Ochiltree County takes the view that the survey should begin at the true northeast corner of the Texas Panhandle, said corner being the northeast and beginning corner of Lipscomb County, being the intersection of 100° west longitude and 36° 30' north latitude; said corner being marked on the ground by concrete monument with the following markings "The Supreme Court of The United States. Northeast corner of Texas. 1928. Latitude 36° 30' 00". Longitude 100° 00' 00". Geodetic." Said monument fully described in report of Samuel S. Gannett, Commissioner to the Supreme Court of the United States in Cause styled "The State of Oklahoma, Complainant VS The State of Texas, Defendant: The United States of America, Intervener." Said report bearing date of July 15th, 1929.

Thence due west along the 36° 30' north latitude 30 lineal miles of 1900.8 varas each for common corner between Lipscomb and Ochiltree Counties.

Thence due south on an observed meridian 30 miles plus for S.W. Corner Lipscomb and S.E. Corner Ochiltree. In case the now established line between Hemphill and Lipscomb Counties hold as established in October 1889, and same is north of the distance for length of east line of Ochiltree County then Ochiltree County should extend on south to take its full distance; the west line of Ochiltree having been established and is now on file in your department.

In view of the fact that E. H. Ervin, Surveyor for Lipscomb county who resides at Follett Texas, and the undersigned are unable to agree on the ~~above~~ starting and ending points of said survey we respectfully submit the above for you consideration and instruction to us.

I greatly appreciate the information you furnished in letters of July 9th and 10th, last and take this opportunity to thank you for further instructions along the matters outlined above.

Please notify each surveyor of your instructions after you have made investigation of same to your satisfaction.
