Dear Judge:

Your letter of August 28th was referred to the Drafting Division and did not catch my attention until yesterday. On the same day you wrote my tentative findings were forwarded to Mr. Ervin at Lipscomb, as stated in my telegram to you yesterday.

You will note from the findings, which probably are now in your hands, that my tentative decision as to the correct point to begin the survey is based on Twichell's corner established in accordance with the orders of the County Court of Ochiltree County and apparently accepted by the Lipscomb County authorities. In later years the boundary between Lipscomb and Hemphill was run by the twocounties and established, the two surveyors apparently beginning at a different meridian from that accepted by Twichell for the Northeast corner of Lipscomb County. The corner established by Twichell is not in the same meridian as the corner established by the two surveyors for Hemphill and Lipscomb counties.

The Ochiltree county authorities submit another proposition, in effect that your contention as to your West line in this controversy is not in accord with the position of your Commissioners Court in fencing the highway crossing it.

I have fixed the 10th of September for final determination of the question.
