a Survey Establishing  
the Eastern Boundary line of Live  
Oak County; a part of the Northern  
and Western boundary lines of Bee  
County, or in fact the lines dividing  
the Counties of Live Oak and Bee.  
Made and Established by the respec-  
-tive Surveyors of said Counties, in  
accordance with the Orders and Concur-  
-rent action of the Commissioners Courts  
of Live Oak and Bee Counties:

Beginning on the West-margin of  
Medio Creek at a point where the lower  
line of G. Childers Survey crossed said  
Creek from which a Mesquite marked  
X bears S. 73° W. 10 Varas, another mes-  
-quite marked Y bears S. 68° W. 17 3/10  
Varas. Thence S. 70° W. with the lower  
line of said G. Childers Survey, and  
with the upper lines of the Gill and Igan  
Surveys, at 5-68 Varas crossed a small  
ravine at 3084. Varas, passed the S.W.  
corner of said Childers Survey at 3158  
Varas, crossed the Eastern line of J. E.  
Wilson's pasture fence at 3669 Varas crossed  
a small ravine, bears N. W. at 3680 Varas  
crossed a larger ravine same course at  
5-225 Varas (~~There camped first night~~)  
(April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1882) at 5-285 Varas a Drain  
at 5-997 Varas John Wilson's house bears  
S. 77° W. at 6723 Varas a Branch bears  
N. 20° W. at 6889 Varas, crossed a

N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 30 $\frac{3}{5}$  Varas. (May 9<sup>th</sup> 1882) at  
13300 Varas set a Post marked 7. at 13747  
Varas, head of a Drain, bears N. 62° W. at  
13847 Varas a small prairie, also another small  
prairie about 50 Varas to the left, at 14667  
Varas a narrow Sandy Drain bro. S. 25° E.  
also a Mott of large L. O. trees bears S.  
25° E. 30 Varas, at 15208 Varas a Post-  
Marked 8 on top of an open hill, whence  
a L. O. 18 inches Dia. marked L bears  
S. 20° W. 60 $\frac{1}{4}$  Varas. (May 10<sup>th</sup> 1882) at 15329  
Varas passed 1082 Varas South of the N. E.  
corner of Survey No. 121 in name of  
Wm. J. Holton at 16190 Varas crossed  
Beville and San Antonio road, set a  
Post marked CO. LINE at 16355 Varas  
Elm Creek bears South at 16392 Varas  
a Drain bears South at 17109 Varas a  
Post marked 9 at 17703 Varas top of  
an open rise, beautiful view eastward  
18,772 Varas a Drain bears South at 19001  
Varas set a Post marked 10. Thursday (May  
11<sup>th</sup> 1882) at 19880 Varas a Drain bears

 set a Post-marked II whence a L. O. 12 in  
 dia. marked L bears N.  $68\frac{1}{4}$  W.  $16\frac{1}{2}$  Varas  
 (May 12<sup>th</sup> 1882) at 2485 $\frac{1}{2}$  Varas passed  
 3863 Varas West of the S. E. corner of  
 Survey No. 121 in the name of W. J. Holton  
 at 3871 $\frac{3}{5}$  Varas intersected the West-line  
 of B. S. & F. Survey No. 1, at 3802 Varas set  
 a Post-marked 2. at 4455 Varas the west  
 bank of Sulphur Creek, whence the mouth  
 of Elm Creek bears N. 40 E. about 250  
 Varas. (Saturday May 13<sup>th</sup> 1882) at 4601  
 Varas passed 462 $\frac{1}{2}$  Varas East of the S. W.  
 corner of said B. S. & F. Survey No. 1 at 5703

corner of John E. Wilson's pasture fence, also the  
S. W. corner of Survey No. in name of Aleota  
at 11400 Varas set the 6<sup>th</sup> Mile Post marked 6.
