County be and he is hereby appointed to survey and establish said
County Boundary of Lubbock County.


Beginning at the North East corner of
said County Established by Ira Millington, State Surveyor as
indicated by the field notes of said Survey:- Beginning at the N.E.
Corner of said County on the 12th day of May 1892; Thence S. 30 miles
establishing line between Lubbock and Crosby Counties and on the 18th
day of May 1892 at the S.E. Corner of said County as established by
this survey thence W. 30 miles to establish Base line between Lubbock
and Lynn Counties and on the 24th day of May 1892 at the S.W. Corner
of Lubbock County, thence North 30 miles to N.W. Corner of said
County as established by State Surveyor, all corners erected to be
of rock or earth mounds.

It is further ordered that a copy of
this order be sent to the Commissioners Court of Crosby and Howard
Counties as Notice of said Survey.
