This office is in receipt of a statement dated October 29th 1917, signed by W. R. Standifer, special surveyor for Lynn County, H. G. Guinn, special surveyor for Lubbock County and W. D. Twichell, special surveyor for Terry County, stating that Lynn county had commenced legal proceedings in the county court of said county to establish the lines between said Lynn county and the counties of Lubbock and Terry, and that the surveyors mentioned disagree as to the proper beginning point from which to survey the line between Lubbock and Lynn Counties, for which reason the matter is referred to this office with request for instructions etc. as provided by law.

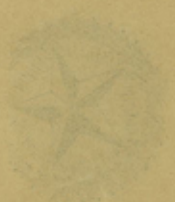
