
IN THE COUNTY COURT OF

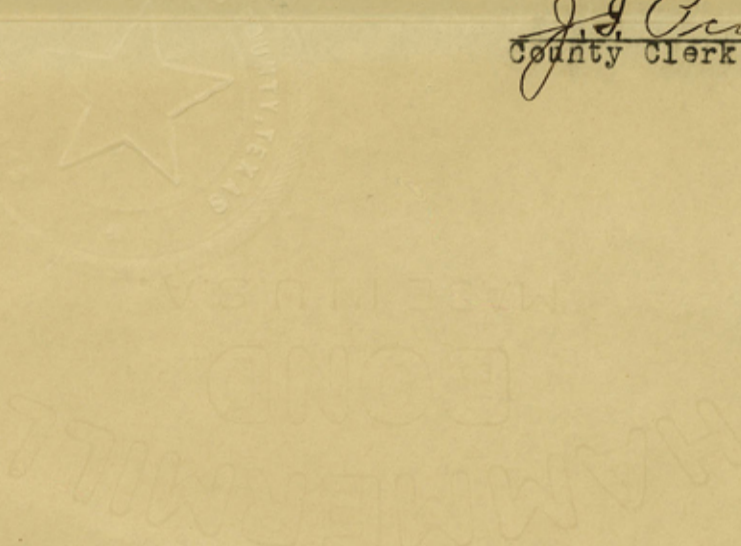
