

The State of Texas
County of Cas. In pursuance of an order of the County
Court of the aforesaid County passed at a
Call Court April 12th 1860 and directed
to me to ascertain, survey and mark the Line between the Counties
of Cas and Marion. I proceeded to Wade W. Vining's in Marion
County adjoining to the Texas and Louisiana Line on the 7th day
of May A D 1860. Being the day and place appointed to
meet the Surveyor or Commissioner appointed by Marion
County to run said Dividing Line. No one appearing
for said County. I proceeded to the Lake Shore North Bank
I ascertained the Lake to be Three Miles and 205 varas
wide the 26th Mile Mound being on the South side of
the Lake and the N E Corner of Thomas Gambelin's Headright
Survey. Peter Swanson ap^c. and the S E Corner of the County
of Cas as established by an act of the Legislature of the
State of Texas Approved April 25th 1856 is the Middle
of Lake Soda

Therefore the S E Corner of
the New County of Marion is One mile (1052 $\frac{1}{2}$) One thousand
& fifty two & $\frac{1}{2}$ varas South of the North Bank of the Lake

Hence running with the Texas & Louisiana Line North
Eleven Miles & (847 $\frac{1}{2}$) Eight hundred & forty seven & $\frac{1}{2}$ varas
makes Thirteen Miles in Accordance with the Act creating
the County of Marion Approved February the 8th 1850
said N E Corner is 1052 $\frac{1}{2}$ varas North of the Sixtieth
(60th) Mile Mound a Stake from which a pine 16 in dia
bears N 86 W 11 varas marked C. a pine 6 in dia bears
S 68 W 10 $\frac{7}{16}$ varas marked M.

Hence one West to the East Boundary of Texas
County ^{a Stake} which is about 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ miles North of Big Cypress
