I see all the new maps of Marion County are not made according to survey on the line lately run between Marion & Harrison Counties. Under an Act entitled an Act to amend a portion of the county of Harrison to the county of Marion and to establish the boundary line between said counties H. B. No 413. Approved April 20<sup>th</sup> 1874. I as the surveyor for Marion County run the line between the said counties as follows. Begin at the SW corner of the D. T. Maule's survey, on the North Bank of Little Cypress Bayou as required in said Act a iron nail marked C. I. (the old corner being down & gone). Thence West 6 1/2 miles to the East Line of S. P. Canterbury Survey a Post about 70 yards west of Pope Springs, and about 1/4 mile N. W. of the swelling of Mrs James a Pine 24 in. dia. br. N. 6 1/2. W. 97 ft. another br. N. 21. W. 100 ft. both marked <sup>C. I.</sup> M + H C.
