



San Saba Co. was created Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> 1856. — Mculloch Co. August 27<sup>th</sup> 1856. —  
and Mason Co. January 22<sup>nd</sup> 1858.

San Saba Co. begins at the mouth of Fall Creek — thence West 38 miles — thence North to  
the Colorado etc. Mculloch Co. begins at the N. W. corner of San Saba Co. thence  
South 35 miles — thence West 30 miles — thence North. Mason Co. begins at the  
S. E. cor. of Mculloch Co. thence South to the S. W. corner of San Saba Co. thence  
East to the N. W. corner of Llano Co. etc.

In 1884 the field notes of the Northline of Mason County, run by D. H. Clark,  
County Surveyor of Mason Co. in Octob. 1879, were returned to the General Land Office.  
These field notes were <sup>rejected</sup> by this Office, because Mculloch and San Saba Co. appear not  
to have been represented in establishing said line, there were no mileposts set and the  
beginning point was not proved to be correct, as no field notes of the San Saba and  
Mculloch Co. lines had been returned to this Office.

The boundary lines of San Saba Co. were established in Septemb. 35. and those of  
Mculloch Co. at the same time, running South from the established S. W. cor. of  
San Saba Co. 35 miles — thence West. The County Surveyor of Mason Co. had been  
notified when these lines were established, but did not appear.
