



San Saba Co. was created Feb. 1st 1856. — McCulloch Co. August 27th 1856.— and Mason Co. January 22nd 1858.

San Saba Co. begins at the mouth of Fall Creek — thence West 38 miles — thence North to the Colorado etc. McCulloch Co. begins at the N.W. corner of San Saba Co. thence South 35 miles — thence West 30 miles — thence North. Mason Co. begins at the S.E. corn. of McCulloch Co. thence South to the S.W. corner of San Saba Co. thence East to the N.W. corner of Llano Co. etc.

In 1884 the fieldnotes of the Northline of Mason County, run by D. H. Clark, County Surveyor of Mason Co. in Octob. 1879, were returned to the General Land Office.

These fieldnotes were ^{rejected} by this Office, because McCulloch and San Saba Cos. appear not to have been represented in establishing said line, there were no mileposts set and the beginning point was not proved to be correct, as no fieldnotes of the San Saba and McCulloch Co. lines had been returned to this Office.

The boundarylines of San Saba Co. were established in Septemt. 85. and those of McCulloch Co. at the same time, running South from the established N.W. corn. of San Saba Co. 35 miles — thence West. The County Surveyor of Mason Co. had been notified when these lines were established, but did not appear.
