The State of Texas } Field Notes of a Survey
 County of Mason } of the North line of Mason
 County made in accordance with an order of
 the County Commissioners Court of Mason County
 dated October the 2nd 1849. Beginning at the South
 East corner of McCulloch Co. a point 35 miles
 S. of the N.E. cor. of McCulloch County in West
 Line of San Saba County a Live Oak tree on the
 point of a hill for a cor. tree from which a
 Post Oak marked $\frac{X}{\equiv}$ bears N. 44° W. $41\frac{1}{5}$ rods another
 Post Oak 17 in dia bears N. $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. $49\frac{1}{5}$ rods another
 18 in dia bears S. 84° W. 69 rods marked C.L.M.Co. Thence -
 West at 400 Varas Mason and East Creek Road at
 One mile and 632 Varas strike W. Line of Pre-
 emptory Survey of A. McWilliams at a point 240
 Varas South of its North West cor at One mile
 and 800 Varas cross East Creek at two miles
 and 178 Varas Dandy Creek at five miles and
 660. Varas cross Burnett & Brady Road at six
 miles and 1360. Varas cross Mason and Vaca
 road at 7 miles 1582. Varas the N.E. cor. of A Watts
 preemption Sur. No. bears South 320 Varas at 7
 miles 1545 Varas cross Katenseys Creek at 9 miles
 1120. Varas East Line of a Preemption Survey of
 80. Acres in name of Shirley the N.E. cor. bears
 North 155 rods. At nine miles 1340 Varas Mason
 and Brady City Road at 13 miles 160 Varas
 cross Westonwood Creek at 15 miles, Bank of
 San Saba River at 15 miles and 120⁰ Varas. -
 Middle of River running N. 65° E. 15 miles and
 400. Varas cross Camp Creek at 18. miles & 500
 Varas Hoag Creek at 21 miles and 1000 Varas -
 Calf Creek at 21. and 1300 strike West Line of
 Sur. No. 241. C. Spangler 225 $\frac{1}{2}$ Varas South of its

1 N. N. cor. At about 23 miles a mesquit tree 12
 2 in dia mcd CL hrs. N. 5 hrs, at 24 miles and 1000
 3 Varas across the Brady & Menardville road at Point
 4 near where the N. N. cor. will stand.

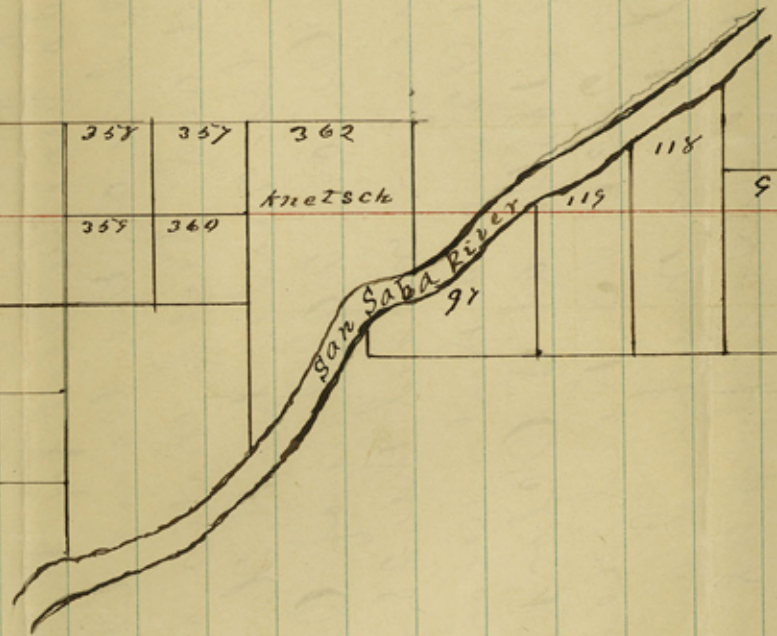

1 Co. Line between Mason & McCulloch Co's. 1849.
2 Report. To the Hon. county commissioners court
3 of Mason county, Gentlemen! In pursuance to an
4 order of your honorable body dated October 2nd A.D. 1849. -
5 Directing me as county Surveyor of Mason Co. to establish
6 the lines between Mason & McCulloch Co's & the line between
7 Mason & Menard and Kimble Co's being the North & West lines of
8 Mason county I have the honor to submit the following report
9 by Agreement with G. Harcourt Esq., Deputy Surveyor of
10 McCulloch Co. I proceeded (on the 20th day of October 1849.)
11 to a place near the corner designated as a beginning to
12 meet said Surveyor Harcourt and after a careful ex-
13 amination found that the S.E. cor. of McCulloch Co. had
14 never been established and that to establish it would be
15 necessary to measure the East line of McCulloch county
16 from its North East cor. South the length of said line
17 as established by the act creating said McCulloch
18 county (Revised Statutes page 149) And that before any
19 line of Mason Co. could be run, this county must be es-
20 tablished. We then agreed to measure said line &
21 proceeded to the N.E. cor. of McCulloch Co. as establish-
22 ed by the Surveyors of McCulloch & San Saba Co's about
23 the year 1844. or 1848 & measured South along a well
24 defined line 35 miles, and established the South East
25 corner, of McCulloch county which is the Begin-
26 ning corner of Mason County (Revised Statutes
27 page 141) and from that point run the line West
28 as directed by the court and as shown in the ac-
29 companying field notes and plat After following
30 the entire length of the South line of McCulloch
31 county, to its South West corner, and failing to
32 find any corner of Menard county or the N.W.
33 cor. of Mason county established I abandoned
34 the work for the following reasons First: - That

1 it was impracticable if not impossible to establish
 2 the North West corner of Mason Co. or the West line
 3 of Mason Co., by running West from its beginning
 4 corner. Because the act creating the county and define
 5 ing its boundaries makes the North line of an indefin-
 6 ite length:

7 2nd That in field notes of Mason Co. boundaries
 8 the calls for course and distance are as follows. -
 9 Beginning at the South ~~W~~ East cor. of McCalluch
 10 Co. Thence South to the South West corner of
 11 San. Saba county. - Thence East to the North
 12 West cor. of Laws county Thence South with
 13 the West line of Laws county to its S. W. cor. Thence
 14 West thirty One (31) Miles Thence North to the
 15 South line of McCalluch county Thence East
 16 to the Beginning 3rd. That I was unable to get a
 17 connecting line or corner of either Menard or Kim-
 18 ble counties on the West side of Mason county each
 19 of these counties being dependant on Mason coun-
 20 ty for their East lines and corners,

21 4 That as I had found it necessary to run the East
 22 and South lines of Mason county to establish
 23 the West line it would be well to make this
 24 statement to the court that on official survey
 25 of these lines might be made at the same
 26 Expense to the county that would establish the
 27 said west line Accompanying this I hand you
 28 the field notes for the survey of the North line
 29 of Mason county Also my account for services
 30 made in accordance with section nine of an
 31 act establishing and prescribing the manner
 32 of ascertaining the boundaries of counties" -
