First Observations Taken at the Mouth of  
Sandy Creek in Slane County on the West  
side of Colorado River, course of the river  
At this point N. from Mouth Sandy, South  
for 1000 yards S. -  $31^{\circ} E.$ . Thence due E. about  
1200 yards. Thence N. -  $45^{\circ} E.$  Distance across  
Colorado River at Mouth of Sandy 300 yards  
Distance across Mouth of Sandy as it now  
stands 220 yards. There is every evidence  
from the Topography of this place. That the  
Mouth of Sandy is now at least 175 yards N.  
 $31^{\circ} E.$  from where it originally was. Begin-  
ning at the center at the Mouth of Sandy Creek  
from which a large Pecan 30' Dia. bxs. \$53 $\frac{1}{2}$   
f. 1466 ft = Also a large Elm 41" Dia bxs. \$81 $\frac{1}{2}$   
f. - 1496 ft. Thence South. - Five miles to the  
Old Original five mile cor. a Stone Md. -  
Thence due West running with a Variation  
of  $9^{\circ} - 30' E.$  Thirty three miles. - To the S.W. cor.  
of Slane which is also the S.E. cor. of Mason  
County said corner is 150 feet West from the  
West bank of Cherry Spring Creek. Situated  
on the Wilkinson Survey No. 131. Due N. 1450  
feet from the N.W. cor. of Sur. No. 398 in the  
name of the Hes. of J. Martin 1450 feet North  
from the South boundary line of said Wilkin-  
son Survey No. 131. A Stake. Thence N. with  
the Solar compass 1460 yds to the first Mile

 md. from which a P.O. 12" dia brs S. 16 E. 9 ft mcd

 N. 1460 yds to the 12<sup>th</sup> mile sta a st. md. from which  
 a P.O. 10" dia brs S. 64½ E. 32 ft. - a B. J. 18" dia  
 brs N. 46½ ft. E. 46. feet. Hence N. 1460 yds to the  
 13<sup>th</sup> mile sta from which a L.O. 16" dia brs N. 4° N.  
 42 ft mcd. M.C. & o. parked 20" dia brs N. 44 N. 51 ft  
 Hence N. 1460 yds to the 14<sup>th</sup> mile sta a P.O. 12"  
 dia brs N. 32½ E. 23 feet & O. 13" dia brs N. 41½°  
 N. 59½ ft. Hence N. 1460 yds to the 15<sup>th</sup> mile sta

a stone from which a L. Q. 12" dia brs N.  
22 E. 100 feet. - Thence N. 1460 yds to the 16<sup>"</sup> mile  
sta. a stnd marked 16 m. from which a L. Q.  
12" dia brs S. 15° N. 30 ft a Rock brs. S. 12 1/2 N.  
40 ft. - Thence N. 1460 yds to the 17<sup>"</sup> mile sta a stnd  
marked 17 m. - Thence 1460 yds to the 18<sup>"</sup> mile sta  
a point 14 yds N. of an erroneous corner. -  
Thence N. 1460 yards to the 19<sup>"</sup> mile sta, a stnd  
from which a B. g. 10" dia. brs. N. 45° E. 45 ft marked  
L. C. a P. O. 12" dia brs N. 5 1/2 N. 63 1/2 ft marked M. b.  
Thence N. 1460 yds to the 20<sup>"</sup> mile sta, a stnd.  
from which a clump of 3 B. g. brs N. 34 N. 46  
feet a ledge of rock brs N. 20 1/2 E. 113 feet. Thence  
N. 3900 ft cross Mason & Valley Springs road  
16 1/2 Miles E. from Mason, Road running E.  
S 280 ft. to the 21<sup>"</sup> mile sta - a. stnd. from wh.  
a P. O. 12" dia brs N. 67 1/2 E. 116 ft. & a. 6" dia brs S. 56  
N. 61 ft. Thence N. 1460 yds to the 22<sup>"</sup> mile sta.  
a stake from which a P. O. 8" dia brs N. 3 1/4 E. 31 ft  
H. 12" dia brs S. 5 1/2 N. 52 1/2 ft. - Thence N. 1460  
yds to the 23<sup>"</sup> mile sta, a stone on the foot  
of the Southern slope of the Western peak of  
Kings Mountain familiarly known as. -

L. C. Thence N. 1460 yds cross Turkey roost moun-  
tain on the Eastern slope of the Western Peak to  
the 24<sup>"</sup> mile sta from which a P. O. 12" dia brs  
S. 42 1/2 N. 19 ft. & a 6" dia brs N. 10° N. E. 68 ft. Thence  
N. 1460 yds to the 25 mile sta in Beadle's field  
no. bearings. - Thence N. 1460 yds to the 26<sup>"</sup> mile  
sta, in the middle of Westermann's a large  
granite rock Branded L. C. 26 m. Thence N.  
1460 yds to the 27<sup>"</sup> mile sta, in Gibbons field

1 no bearings. - Thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° 00' yds to the 28" mile  
 2 Sta. a st. md. - from which a S.O. 12" dia bxs S. 44.6°  
 3 60 ft. a L.O. 10" dia bxs S. 64.7°. 56 ft. Thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° 00'  
 4 yds to the 29" Mile Sta. just West of M.M. Leavens  
 5 house some 40 yds West of house. Thence N. 19° 00'  
 6 feet intersects the South boundary line of Dan  
 7 Daba County 120 yds S. from M.M. Leavens  
 8 North Line and 350 yds West from M.M. Leav-  
 9 eness E. line a flat rock from which a clump  
 10 of 3 B. & J. bxs N. 82 ft. - a flat rock in bed of Ra-  
 11 vine bxs N. 40° E. 51 ft. - md. L. B. & M. Co., All Bear-  
 12 ings West marked Md. M.C. All Bearings E.  
 13 Md. - L.C. This we establish as the N.W. cor. of  
 14 Lland. County. and N.E. cor. of Mason. Co. Thence  
 15 due N.  $4\frac{4}{5}$  miles due N. with the original Dan  
 16 Daba line to a point which is due N. 38 miles  
 17 from the Mouth of Fall Creek a large rock  
 18 Md. from which a S.O. "dia bxs due. N.  
 19 ft. da.      n.      ft. The South  
 20 West corner of Dan Daba County.

Be it remembered that a Commissioners Court, was begun <sup>and</sup> held in and for Mason County Texas, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June A.D. 1886. Among other things the following. - Proceedings were had. -

Then came on for consideration, Examination or rejection the Report of John T. Stapleton under contract with this court, to run the County Line between Mason & Llano Counties and he having filed his report as required by law. And the same having been duly examined by the court, And it appearing to the court that said John T. Stapleton had actually run, Measured, Surveyed <sup>and</sup> established said East Line of Mason County in strict conformity with Law and had made due return of the Field Notes and Map of said County Line to this court. It is therefore ordered by the court, that said map be record <sup>ed</sup> and in all things approved.

And it is further ordered by the court, that the same be recorded as the Law directs, and certified copy be made and forwarded as the Law directs.
