Resurvey of McLennan County
line, concluded May 8th 1848 by
Kell, McLennan, County Surveyor

Beginning at a point on the West
bank of the Brazos River, and in the
North line of the County, as established
by previous survey, and as directed
by law, said point being about
fifteen miles from Waco, and further
designated by an Ash Tree marked
McLennan County Line. Thence, running
S 60° W (860 Varas to a point opposite to,
and distant 1635 Varas N 30° W from the
N E corner of the Miquel Robago
Grant) putting up Cedar stakes at the
end of every mile and stone mounds
at all road crossings, at 3 miles
1660 Varas cross Childers creek 6 miles
1500 Varas cross Waco & Clifton road
10 miles 780 Varas East line of the
John McLennan Survey, (700 Varas N 30° W
from the S E corner of said Survey)
at 11 miles 780 Varas cross Bosque River
at 12 miles cross Waco and Meridian road
12 miles 440 Varas to the West line of
the McLennan Survey, 12 miles 1260 Varas
cross Bellon & Fort Graham road, 14 miles
133 Varas cross Hainsville & Clifton road

15 miles 570 Varas Cross Waco & Hamil
in road, 15 miles 1510 Varas cross
Hogg Creek 19 miles 1340 Varas cross
Middle Basque, 21 miles 500 Varas
to the NW corner of McLennan County
in the East line of Coryell County.
said NW corner being 2490 Varas
N 30 W from the NE corner of the
lot ^{part of John Woodham} Saddle prumption Survey, and
is designated by a cedar Post properly
marked. Thence running S 30 E at
2 miles cross Rainey Creek, 2 miles 340
Varas cross upper road from Waco to
Gatesville 4 miles 710 Varas cross Bluff
Creek 6 miles 1657 Varas to fork of Tongue
Creek, 9 miles 150 Varas cross Tributary
of Tongue Creek 12 miles 840 Varas
lower road from Waco to Gatesville
13 miles 300 Varas Waco & Lampasas road
14 miles 700 Varas Station Creek road
18 miles 800 Varas Belton & Fort Gra
ham road, 22 miles 1400 Varas cross
a prong of Stampede Creek 23 miles
1460 Varas another prong of same creek
at 25 miles 1700 Varas cross Belton & Perryville
road, at 27 miles 1600 Varas set and
mark post for SW cor of McLennan
County

Begin at a point on the East bank
of the Brazos River in the North line
of the County and opposite to, and
N 60 E from the point described as
the beginning of this survey, further
designated by an Pecan tree marked
W L Co Sur. Thence running, N 60 E
at 5 miles 1360 Varas cross Waco & Fort
Graham road 6 miles 1260 Varas cross
cross Aguilera Creek, at 14 miles 350 Varas
cross Waco & Dallas road, at 16 miles
set and mark stake for N E corner
of M Leman County.

Thence running S 35 E at 2 miles
cross a branch of Tehuacama Creek
at 3 miles cross another branch of
same Creek at 8 miles 450 Varas cross
Main Tehuacama, at 9 miles 600 Varas
cross another branch of same Creek,
at 12 miles cross Waco & Corsicana
road, at 12 miles 1300 Varas road from
Waco to Tehuacama Hills 14 miles
900 Varas cross Little Tehuacama, at
15 miles 500 Varas cross branch of same
Creek, at 16 miles 600 Varas cross another
branch, at 17 miles 850 another, at
18 miles 100 Varas Waco & Springfield road
at 19 miles 1490 Varas cross Tradinghouse
Creek, at 21 miles 350 Varas cross

Dallas Hillsboro & Marlin road, 21
 miles 1150 Varas head of Big Creek,
 at 27 miles 1500 Varas set and mark
 Post for S E cor of McLennan County
 Thence running South at 1470 Varas
 pass the corner of a survey name unknown
 at 1 mile 30 Varas cross Big Creek, at 4 miles
 500 Var cross a branch of same, at 5 miles
 540 Var cross Marlin & Dallas road,
 11 miles 700 Var cross Sandy creek 8 miles
 1300 Var another prong of same, 11 miles
 1460 Varas Marlin & Tracy Road, 13 miles 950
 Varas to the Brazos River, marked a hollow
 tree on bank of river M.L.C.S. Crossing
 the Brazos and running South along the
 north line of the Franks League, at 5 miles
 cross Tracy & Marlin road, at 11 miles
 North low Bayou, 11 miles 400 Varas to
 the West line of the John Bector League
 11 miles 800 Varas, connect with the N.W. cor
 of the Pedro Yagaja Grant, distance S 30° E
 300 Varas, at 12 miles 1140 Varas cross South
 low Bayou, at 14 miles 1100 Varas cross
 Tracy & Cameron Road, at 18 miles 320
 Varas cross Deer creek, 18 miles 1040 Varas
 South prong of Deer Creek, at 20 miles
 1300 Varas a branch of Elm Creek, at
 21 miles 1060 Varas cross Elm Creek
 23. 1970 vs. S. W. corner.

at 23 miles 1370 Varas the S W corner
of McLennan County.

The following connections were
made on the North County line East
of the Brazos, no positive information
however, could be had of original Corners
or Original Granters. It is possible that the
names here given as Original Granters
may be present Owners.

13 miles N 60° E from the Brazos
River the County line passes through
the center of a survey of 960 Acres in
the name of E. Paland. at 14 miles 400 Varas
cross the East line of a survey in the
name of John Oliver 800 Varas from the
N E corner thereof. at 15 miles 400 Varas
cross the East line of a survey in the
name of B. C. Carter, 400 Varas from the
S E corner thereof.
