Resurvey of McLennan County
line, Concluded May 8th 1818 by
Tull, McLennan County Surveyor

Beginning at a point on the West
bank of the Brazos River, and in the
North line of the County, as established
by previous Survey, and as directed
by law, said point being about
fifteen miles from Waco. And further
designated by an Ash Tree marked
McLennan County Line. Thence running
 $S 60^{\circ} W$ (860 Yaras to a point opposite to,
and distance 1635 Yaras $N 30^{\circ} W$ from the
NE corner of the Miguel Robago
Grant) putting up Cedar stakes at the
end of every mile and stone mounds
at all road crossings, at 3 miles
1660 Yaras cross Childrens creek 6 miles
1500 Yaras cross Waco & Belton road
10 miles 780 Yaras East line of the
John McLennan Survey. (700 Yaras $N 30^{\circ} W$
from the SE corner of said Survey)
at 11 miles 780 Yaras cross Bosque River
at 12 miles cross Waco and Meridian road
12 miles 440 Yaras to the West line of
the McLennan Survey. 12 miles 1260 Yaras
cross Bellon & Fort Graham road, 14 miles
133 Yaras cross Lairsville & Belton road.

15 miles 570 Varas cross Waco & Hamilton
line road, 15 miles 1610 Varas cross
Hogg Creek 19 miles 1340 Varas crop
Middle Bosque, 21 miles 500 Varas
to the NW corner of McLennan County
in the East line of Coryell County.
Said NW corner being 2490 Varas
N 30 W from the NE corner of the
Lefol Saddler ^{area of John Needham} pre-emption Survey, and
is designated by a cedar post properly
marked. Thence running S 30 E at
2 miles cross Rainey's Creek, 2 miles 840
Varas crop upper road from Waco to
Gatesville 4 miles 710 Varas crop Bluff
creek 6 miles 1657 Varas to fork of Tongue
creek, 9 miles 158 Varas cross tributary
of Tongue creek 12 miles 840 Varas
lower road from Waco to Gatesville
13 miles 300 Varas Waco & Lampasas road
14 miles 700 Varas Station Creek road
18 miles 800 Varas Bellon & Fort Gra-
ham road. 22 miles 1400 Varas cross
a prong of Stampede Creek 23 miles
1460 Varas another prong of same creek
at 25 miles 470 Varas crop Bellon & Perryville
road, at 27 miles 1600 Varas set and
mark post for SW cor of McLennan
County

Begin at a point on the East bank
of the Brazos River in the North line
of the County and opposite to, and
N 60° E from the point described as
the beginning of this survey, further
designated by an pecan tree marked
McL Lee Line. Thence running N 60° E
at 5 miles 1360 Yaras crop Waco & Fort
Graham road 6 miles 1260 Yaras crop
crop Aguilla creek, at 14 miles 350 Yaras
crop Waco & Dallas road, at 16 miles
set and mark stone for N E corner
of McLennan County.

Thence running S 35° E at 2 miles
crop a branch of Tehuacanna creek
at 3 miles crop another branch of
same creek at 8 miles 450 Yaras crop
main Tehuacanna, at 9 miles 600 Yaras
crop another branch of same creek,
at 12 miles crop Waco & Losacaña
road, at 12 miles 1800 Yaras road from
Waco to Tehuacanna Hills 14 miles
900 Yaras crop Little Tehuacanna, at
15 miles 370 Yaras crop branch of same
creek, at 16 miles 600 Yaras crop another
branch, at 17 miles 850 another, at
18 miles 100 Yaras Waco & Springfield road
at 19 miles 14,90 Yaras crop Paddinghouse
creek, at 21 miles 384 Yaras crop

Dallas Hillsboro & Marlin road, 21 miles 1150 varas head of Big Creek. at 27 miles 1500 varas set and mark Post for S E bor of Williamson County. Thence running S 60 W at 1470 varas pass the corner of a survey's name continuing at 1 mile 300 varas crop Big Creek, at 4 miles 800 varas cross a branch of same, at 5 miles 540 varas cross Marlin & Dallas road. 7 miles 700 varas crop Sandy creek 8 miles 1300 varas another prong of same, 11 miles 1460 varas Marlin & Waco Road, 13 miles 950 varas to the Brazos River, marked a hollow tree on bank of river M L. B. S. Cropping the Brazos and running S 60 W along the north line of the Franks League, at 5 miles crop Waco & Marlin road, at 11 miles North low Bayou, 11 miles 400 varas to the west line of the John Beclon League 11 miles 800 varas, connect with the N W line of the Pedro Yagaja Grant, distance 830' 8 300 varas, at 12 miles 1140 varas crop South low Bayou, at 14 miles 1100 varas cross Waco & Cameron Road, at 18 miles 320 varas crop Deer creek, 18 miles 1040 varas south prong of Deer Creek, at 20 miles 1300 varas a branch of Elm Creek, at 21 miles 1060 varas crop Elm Creek

at 23 miles 1370 Yards the SW corner
of McLennan County.

The following connections were
made on the North County line East
of the Brazos, no positive information
however, could be had of original Owners
or Original Grantees. It is possible that the
names here given as Original Grantees
may be present Owners.

13 miles N 60° E from the Brazos
River the County line passes through
the center of a Survey of 960 Acres in
the name of E. Palaud. at 14 miles 400 Yards
cross the East line of a Survey in the
name of John Oliver 800 Yards from the
NE corner thereof. at 15 miles 400 Yards
cross the East line of a Survey in the
name of B. C. LeMaster, 400 yards from the
SE corner thereof,
