It seems that by some mistake that you have called for the corner made by Mr. Diddell when he ran the line about a year ago which corner is a sub quadrant half of one more south of the original Cor of Cherry and was made by Diddell by using S. 60° W from the Cor of Bosque opposite the S. Dear Sir

In obedience to
your instruction I met Mr Siddall
Co. Surveyor of Bosque Co. on the
west bank of the Brazos river to run
the line from a point opposite to the
SW corner of Hill Co. direct to the
NW corner of McLennan Co. He Siddall
positively refuses to run the line as
plainly laid down by ~~the~~ the Commissioner
of the Land office. He is furnished
a map by Hon W. C. Walsh which is certainly
unmistakable. It gives the original line
and also the line that shall be run, said
map is a fine and true map, and shows
that the new line to be run, commences
at a point on the west side of the river
opposite the Hill County corner last ~~est~~
established. Hence in a direct line to the
NW corner of McLennan Co., pointedly and
positively connecting the new line with
the original ~~corner~~ line at said corner,
which shows clearly without doubt that
Commissioner Walsh intended us to run
to that corner. Which corner, ~~has been~~

is only known by a pile of rocks and the line leading off No 2, connecting the N. line of this co. North ^{or East} of the river,

But after connecting the new and original line at the corner, Mr. Walsh proceeds to give the post, the letters on said post, the bearings &c, of the corner made by Mr. Siddall, which ^{is} a conflict, ^{in his construction} from the fact that I am sure that he intends us to run to the original corner his map show it, his written instruction show it, He closes us at the N.W. corner. But by mistake give Siddalls field notes which Siddall claims that he will go to, because the Commissioner said so, while he admits that every thing else show that we should go to the original corner, Siddall claims that Comr Walsh has virtually accepted of his line to which I took issue, I hope that the matter will be attended to while hands are not ~~too~~ busily engage to run lines
