

To Hon G. B. Gerald, Judge of County Court
of County Court of McLennan County -
Sir -

In obedience to your orders, and
the instructions of the Com. of the Genl.
Land Office, I proceeded on behalf of
McLennan County in conjunction
with S. J. Seddall on behalf of Bos-
que County, to establish and define
the line between the two aforesaid
Counties, as follows, to wit:

Began at a point on the west
bank of the Brasos River which
is S. 60° W. from the S. W. Cor. of Hill
County and the N. W. Cor. of the Samuel
Rice Survey, at which planted a square
cedar post 3 ft in the ground and 3 ft
above, marked on the N. Side S. E. C. O. R.
B. O. C. O. and on the S. Side N. W. LINE. McL.
and from which a scragly Pecan tree
24 in. dia. marked B. by S. 34½ E. 3¾
rs and a Hackberry tree 12 in. dia marked
M. by S. 16¼ W. 4 rs -

Thence S. 61° 6" W. (Mag. Va. 9° 22" East)
Side lines in timber marked with two hacks
and line, or "fore and aft" trees marked with a
blaze and hacks above and below on either side,
at 3 miles 996 rs to Childers' house, width
40 rs, course S. 44. E.; at the 6 mile point
in prairie a Lone Elm 15-in. dia. U. D. C.
B. A. 1883 on south side and R. F. O. R. &
E. E. M. on the north side, and by me B above

brs N. $37\frac{1}{2}$. E. $331\frac{1}{2}$ vs; at 6 miles 1240
vs Roco & Meridian Road; at 8 miles
460 vs Roco & Valley Mills ~~Road~~ Road;
at 10 miles 1280 vs north bank of North Bosque
River at a bend running down S. 70. E. and
up the river S. 68. W., width 60 vs.; passed
over to south bank at 140 vs, ran up the
margin of south bank for 480 vs to the
11th mile and erected a monument of rock
on the bank, which is 10 vs S. 30. E. of the
real line in a field on the John McLenon
Survey, this monument on the true
line would be about the edge of the
water at low water. From this point
the line runs along the water's edge for
about 300 vs, when the river turns in
a west and northwestwardly direction;
at 12 miles and 120 vs Valley Mills Road;
at 12 miles and 394 vs G. C. & Santa
Fe R. Road at which marked "COUNTY
LINE" on a board and fastened some on
a telegraph post, course of R. R. S. 12.
E.; at 12 miles and 1190 vs Crawford and
Valley Mills road at right angles; at
13 miles and 131 vs a L. O. 12 in. dia. a
"fore & aft" marked "C. L." on either side and
bearing S. 25. W. about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile
from the Depot at Valley Mills; at 15-
miles 1757 vs Hog Creek, width 20 vs,
course S. 57. E.; at 20 miles the north
edge of a very high rock bluff on north
side of Middle Bosque; at 20 miles

1 and 200 vs Middle Bosque, 35 vs wide on course
2 S. 43. E., in all 40 895 vs, or 21 miles 995 vs
3 to the N. W. cor of McLennon and the S. W. cor.
4 of Bosque County in the East line of
5 Coryell County in the J. J. Goodman
6 Survey S. 60. W. 1489 vs and S. 30. E. 498
7 vs from the N. E. cor. of the said Survey

8 and from which a clump of 5 L. O.
9 one mottled M brs S. 63. E. 193 and
10 another mottled B brs S. 62 ³/₄ E. 195 vs.
11 At the terminus of each mile planted
12 a cedar post or erected a rock
13 monument from 2 ¹/₂ to 3 ft
14 high.

15 In addition to the above the fol-
16 lowing facts, in regard to Survey
17 lines crossed, are submitted.

18 The initial point, or S. E. corner
19 of Bosque County is the basis of all
20 remarks - This point is in the M.
21 Rabijo Survey and S. 30. E. 2700 vs
22 from the north line of same - At
23 20300 vs crossed the west line of
24 Rabijo Survey 2954 vs S. 28. E. from
25 the N. W. cor. of same as established
26 by S. M. Jenkins. (Conflict with
27 John McLennon Survey about 400 vs)

28 Enter John McLennon Survey and
29 ran about 50 vs north of the C. J.
30 Hall north line and near north line of
31 same known and John Simpston Sur-
32 vey - Enter Wm Lawrence and
struck Wm Campbell Survey 902
vs from its S. E. cor. Enter Sam
Johnson Survey at 1791 vs N. 30. W.

from his S. E. cor. - Passed through
the surveys of M. L. Segoll, C. B. James,
P. J. Blaise, L. H. Scrutshfield, T.
Garcia and a Scrips Survey to the
opposite N. W. & S. W. corner in
Goodman Run on Boyell line
