TO HON G. B. GERALD, County Judge of McLennan County, Texas:-

We, the undersigned surveyors appointed by our respective County Judges of McLennan and Limestone Counties, to define the line between said Counties, met at the time and place agreed upon by said Judges after mutually agreeing proceeded, viz: Beginning at the post which stands S30E 12 miles and 335 varas from the N. E. corner of McLennan County, said post is marked on the North side H cor (being the South corner of Hill County) and on the East side LNW, and on the West side McL from which a PO 15 in dia marked MHL brs S76W 62 varas and a mesquite 7 in dia mkd X brs S40 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 79 vrs, do 4 in dia mks L brs S55E 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ vrs; said corner or post being situated 409 vrs N60E from the S W corner of the B M Hunter Survey and the N W corner of Wm W Boren's Survey; thence S 30 E a continuation of the East line of McLennan County, at one mile a mound at one mile 780 vrs cross a creek at 940 vrs cross Williams Creek at 1410 vrs a point S60W about 170 vrs from Frank Davis' residence on Boren League, crossing South line of Wm W Borens Survey N60E 496 vrs from S W corner of said Survey, at 2 miles a mound at 3 miles a mound, at 3 miles & 780 vrs cross prong of Tehuacana Creek about 40 vrs above mouth of another creek at 1600 vrs cross Salt Creek, at 4 miles a mound and at 4 miles & 1710 vrs cross Waco & Mexia Road (bearing S60E) at a point S60W 42 vrs from a tenant house of W. R. Sheads, at 5 miles a mound in Wm R. Shead's field, at 5 miles & 520 vrs to a point N60E 105 vrs from the East chimney of W. R. Shead's residence, at 5 miles 900 vrs cross Waco & Groesbeck Road, at 6 miles a mound, at 6 miles 680 vrs cross Tradinghouse Creek, at 7 miles a mound at 7 miles & 60 vrs cross small creek, at 7 miles & 1250 vrs a point S60W 500 vrs from Pettus S W corner, at 7 miles 1350 vrs cross Marlin Road at 8 miles a mound, at 9 miles a mound, at 10 miles a mound, at 10 miles & 700 vrs cross South line of E.B. Smith pasture on Dillon Survey at a point N60E 862 vrs from his SW corner of his fence, at 11 miles a mound at 11 miles & 1740 vrs to house of Mr. Henderson leaving said house East of line and about 60 vrs West of said House a dwelling, grove and well in the yard, at 12 miles a mound passing at the N W corner of Ephraim Smith's Survey, at 13 miles a mound at 13 miles 420 vrs center of the new Groesbeck & Waco Road at point about 1/2 mile N60E from Mart also about 40 vrs N60E from mouth of lane going to Mart, at 14 miles a mound in East line of Chapman Survey, continuing S30E

at 14 miles 1835 vrs N. E. corner of Falls County.

The foregoing report & map accompanying are respectfully submitted.
