a Sycamore 7 in. dia. bears N. 46 1/2° W. 7 paces, a two forked
Elm 5 in. dia. bears S. 4° E. 3 3/4 paces.

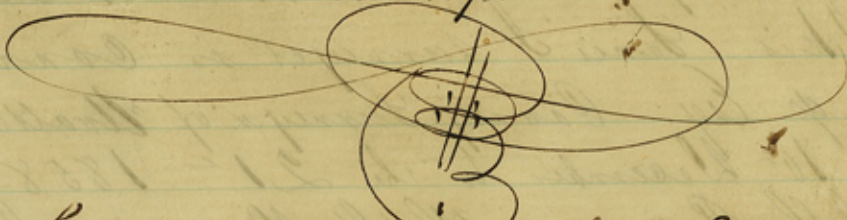
