Menard County on the 20th day of June 1880
and the line between Kimble and Menard
counties to be commenced at the S W cor-
ner of Menard county on June 23rd 1880

There being no further business before the
Court it is ordered that it do now adjourn

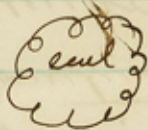

It appearing to the Court that the
clerk hereof has received from the Hon
Commissioners Court of Menard County
Official notification that the said County
Court of Menard has ordered a Survey
of the boundary line between said Menard
County & Crockett County & has author-
ized empowered & employed a Survey
or to run said line and it appearing
further to the Court that the interests
of this County demands that this said
County shall be represented in the
matter of this proposed and ordered
Survey & it appearing to the Court

that B. D. Footo Esq, is a proper person
to represent said County as surveyor
~~or~~ in the said matter of said proposed
& ordered to survey, it is therefore ordered
adjudged & Decreed by the Court that
the said B. D. Footo Esq be & he is hereby
appointed to run & Establish said bound-
ary line between said Menard & Crockett
counties and that he shall begin to run
said line at the North west corner of
said Menard County which is the North
East corner of said Crockett County

Commencing on the 20th day of
June 1880 - It is further the order
Judgement and decree of the Court that
said B. D. Footo shall take the oath
and file the bond required by the law
in this class of cases

The Court further orders adjudges &
decrees that the Clerk of this Court shall
give to the said Hon Commissioners Court
of Menard County Official Notice of
the action of this ^{Court} in the matter.

Thereupon came the said B. D. Footo
and in obedience to the order of this Court
heretofore made filed a bond in the sum
of One thousand dollars conditioned
as the law directs with H. Emerick

and W^m Wahrmond as sureties
which said bond was approved by the
Court,

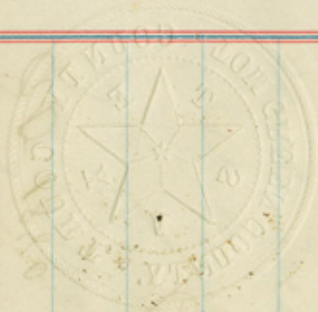
